ATLANTIC PACT IS ALMOST READY

Portugal says 'no bases' 'A WEAKENING FACTOR'

WITH the final stage in the negotiations for the North Atlantic Pact rapidly approaching, Portugal is the latest of the big powers to state her attitude to the proposed alliance, and she has confirmed that she is seeking more information, but she has stated that she will not allow her territory to be used as a base for the pact in peacetime and has "regretted" the inclusion of Spain.

The statement, from the Portuguese embassy in Washington, said that the pact, as it has been reported that the important point under discussion in Lisbon was whether Portugal would make bases in either Portugal or the Azores available to other signatories of the pact in peacetime, particularly to the United States.

The embassy statement made it clear that Portugal would accept such a condition. The statement goes on to say that Portugal would not accept a condition that Portugal would go on in Lisbon and Washington to obtain more information about the pact, and that the pact could only weaken the position of Portugal.

Representatives of the Kenya Tea Growers' Association yesterday put their demand to the Co-L. Commissioner in Nairobi for an increase of an average of 25 cents a pound in the wholesale price of tea supplied to the local market. 'All under one hat', urges a leader

By a unanimous vote at the annual meeting on Saturday at Nakuru, the Stockowners Association decided to amalgamate with the Kenya National Farmers' Union, becoming the Stockowners' Section of the Union. Referring later to this decision the Secretary for Agriculture (Major F. W. Cavendish-Bennick) declared: "I welcome it. It has always been difficult for anyone in my position to ascertain really what the agricultural industry as a whole wants. More than most industries agriculture is divided into a number of sections and there is sometimes a difference of opinion among them."

"It will be easier with the growth of the K.N.F.U. which is gradually absorbing all the various sections of the industry.
