

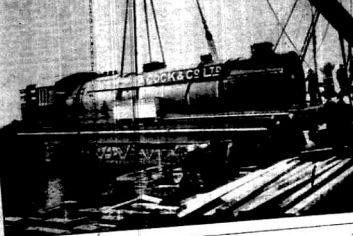

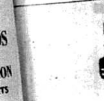

Wonder fibre COMMODITY in full-scale production

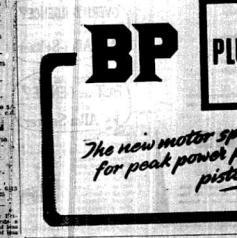

A CORNER OF FRANCE IN KENYA



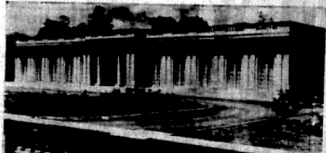
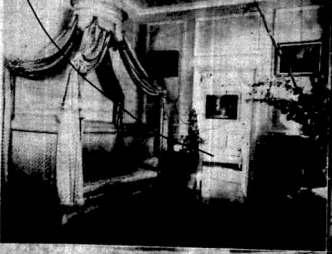
A SENTIMENTAL memory of his home at La Touraine, near Tours, led M. Jean-Pierre Pichot, President of the Alliance Française in East Africa, and owner of the oldest coffee plantations in Kenya, to build his Kenya house in the style of the Trianson at Versailles.

The foundation for the period of history during which the Trianson was at the height of its fame, allied to the reminiscence his family home bore to it, contributed to the erection in the Colony of what has already become something of a museum piece, in that visitors from all over East Africa flock to view the wonder—his French period furniture and the objects d'art which fill what M. Pichot so aptly calls La Trianson in Nakuru Avenue, Muthanga.

Story of the original

It was to please Madame de Montespan that in 1678 Louis XIV ordered the building in the Park of Versailles of what was then called the "Trianson de Versailles." This palace was destroyed by the King's order in 1693 and on the site was built the actual "Grand Trianson" which was given by Louis XIV to Madame de Montespan, whom he had secretly married three years earlier. The architect of the Grand Trianson was Jules Hardouin Mansart. Later, King Louis XV gave it to Queen Marie Leszcynska, and her father, the King of Poland, used to visit there when he was in France. In 1790 the Palace was occupied by the new favourite, Madame de Pompadour, and the year 1790 found Queen Marie Antoinette spending much of her time there.
