COFFEE EXPORT TAX OFF IN TANGANYIKA

No indication to trade of similar action by Kenya

The export tax on Tanganyika coffee has been lifted by the Government after eight months of the lowest level of coffee on the world markets, brought about partly by the recent manipulation of Brazilian coffee.

AT HOME WITH THE CONSULS

This week, in her series, JOY NICHOLL writes of the Ethiopian Consul-General in Kenya, Mr. Berhanou Tessema.

LOOKING at a map of the world, there do not seem many expanses of the earth's surface which Mr. Berhanou Tessema has not covered. For this tall, handsome Ethiopian Consul-General has a real passion for travel for going places and seeing things whenever the opportunity presents itself.

Apart from journeys involved in his career as a diplomat, he has covered as a diplomat, every spot of leave to be off somewhere with his camera and his gun—for photography and bird-shooting are hobbies which he much enjoys.

Although Mr. Tessema only came to Kenya as

LATER that year came a very different experience, when, with his first entry into the foreign service, he was appointed as second secretary to the Ethiopian Legation in Moscow.

He arrived in mid-winter, Russian officials at the time and strangers of it all to those who were his first representatives of the Allied nations could go about quite easily and he was able to visit Leningrad where he had the famous Hermitage and the Fabergé jewels and the many places of scenic interest.

It was in Moscow that he was first captivated by the art of ballet, an interest which has continued with him ever since. IN 1931 Mr. Tessema went to London, overland, via Sweden, Denmark, Germany, Austria, Switzerland, and France, where as a consul general he was in command of the city which he thinks gives you the longer you remain there. He didn't even mind the climate which he found all right after Moscow winters. Mr. Tessema has on the walls of his lounge two prints of East 100 years ago when he visited Ethiopia. They convey some of the beauty and color of this country's past, and are set against a spot over the century, remaining so even when surrounded by countries who were over to him, Ethiopia belongs to the Coptic Church, the earliest form of Christianity, and there are many monasteries scattered throughout the country. Ethiopia's recent history goes back for over 2000 years, and Mr. Tessema has seen some of the most ancient ruins and sites which the universal language, the script, somewhat resembles Chinese.

ETHIOPIANS, Mr. Tessema says, are basically a mountain people with all the hardy, brave characteristics which mountain folk seem to have in the world. 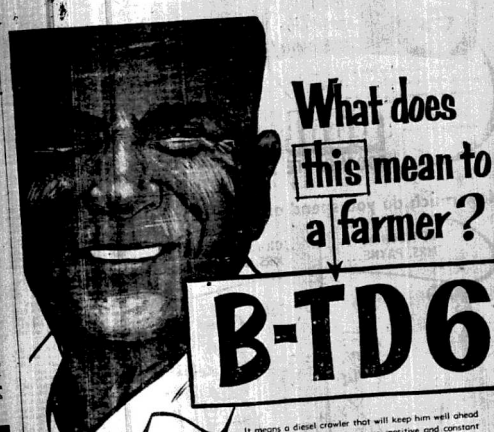

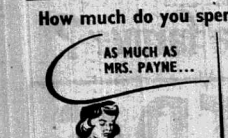



STEP TO RAISE MOMBASA PORT CAPACITY

Administration puts accent on more small lighters

By using small lighters, tugs and mobile cranes and by providing more sheds, the East African Railways and Harbours Administration hopes that within a few months the capacity of Mombasa port will be nearly that anticipated in the disaster on December 15 last, when the port was almost completely blocked by a deep-sea vessel which ran aground.

The method of temporarily increasing the port capacity was first suggested by the Administration after reviewing the situation on the spot and the need to increase the capacity of the port by concentrating on the lighterage.
