The 20-year time limit for the attainment of self-government by Tanganyika, recommended by the U.N. visiting mission, was criticized by the Australian delegate to the Trusteeship Council in New York as "positively harmful."

The delegate, Mr. William Forgan, said that he already considered misunderstandings in the Territory had tended to confront the people with the unhappy choice between giving their loyalty to the administrative authority in the U.N. or to a British-entitled Government.

Air travel at cheap rates forecast

RESULT OF BRITISH PROGRESS IN JETS

A prospect of cheap long-distance air travel... would soon be made possible by developments in British gas turbine engine industry... made by Mr. E. G. Bowyer, director of the British Aircraft Corporation, in a talk to the East African Air Club.

HIGHLIGHTS OF AMERICAN PAINTING.

This week's picture page is a preview of some of the paintings which will be on view at the exhibition "Highlights of American Painting" which will be held in the National Library in Olympic House, Sadler Street, Nairobi, from Monday, March 20, until Saturday, March 26. The exhibition will be open every day from 10 a.m. until 6 p.m.

The paintings in the exhibition were selected by art critics for the United States Information Agency to illustrate representative American paintings from the early Colonial period, mid-17th Century, to the present time. There are 41 pictures, some "sealed" by a baking process in light masonry panels. The perfection of this process has made it possible to show the collection, even though it is to be moved by the exhibitor from place to place. When the exhibit has been removed from the exhibition, the promoters say that unusual directness and clarity of vision, here and there, with a corresponding simplicity of statement are the underlying characteristics of American art.

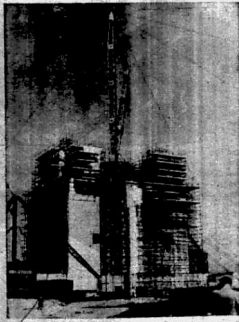
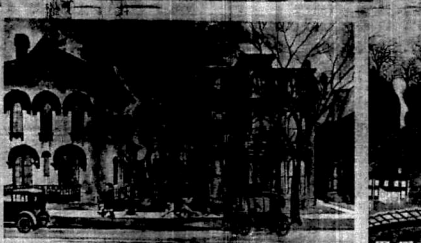


Over the past several days these features were present and now, having become sufficiently pronounced, they are recognized as the mark of the American style.

No country, it is said to have an art of its own until the work of its artists shows a native confidence and drawing inspiration and direction from their home environment rather than debt to European masters.

It is noteworthy, say the promoters, that in all the various movements and individual styles developed in American art, variety, even diversity, is markedly apparent. This in itself is characteristic, as in all periods of history, art reflects the traits of its people. Just as this exhibition highlights the history of American painting, it reflects the character of the American people who are drawn from a variety of countries and races and who have brought with them traditions and customs that have been woven into America's national heritage.

The pictures reproduced here are just a selection, taken at random, to whet the appetite of art lovers in Kenya, a small country which, possibly because of its scenic beauty, is regarded by many as having an unusually high proportion of artists and art lovers among its population.

AT HOME WITH THE CONSULS

This week in her series, JOY NICHOLL writes of MR. SPIRO MONNAS, the Acting Honorary Consul for Greece.

SINCE the time when Lord Byron captured the imagination of the world and the enduring admiration of Greek patriots by his active participation in Greece's struggle to free herself from Turkish domination, there has existed a tradition of close friendship between Britain and Greece.

This tradition has remained unchanged through the generations, and the two countries remain tied by bonds based on a mutual love of freedom and liberation. Mr. Spiro Monnas, the Acting Honorary Consul for Greece, embodies in himself and his family an example of this special bond, for he not only was a member in Kenya and Greece, but also strong roots in England, where he has a house at Westwirth, near Southampton. He spends several months of every year there, and has had a great deal of education, outlook and opinion with Britain.

Born in Moshi

Mr. Spiro Monnas was actually born in Moshi, Tanganyika, being taken home to Athens for the first time at the

age of three. He is the son of Mr. A. S. Monnas, well known in East Africa, who first came to Tanganyika in 1900 and possessed in colonial days the best business and mining farms. He was recently responsible for the donation of the £40,000 needed to build the new Greek Orthodox Church, which adds greatly to the prestige of the colony in poor health, he is now in his Athens home, where his son will be visiting.

After finishing his education in Athens, Mr. Spiro Monnas went to England and enrolled as a student at the London School of Economics and subsequently continued his studies in this subject at Peterhouse College, Cambridge. In 1941 he went into Government service and was attached to the Greek Embassy in London. In 1942, he resigned to volunteer for the Free Greek Navy, and was subsequently based at Chatham, Liverpool and Barrow-in-Furness, he served for some time in convoy. During these years, he formed many friends in London, and now feels that in 1944 that he knows his wife and children better than he does his own parents, his wife being taken home to Athens for the first time at the

age of three. He is the son of Mr. A. S. Monnas, well known in East Africa, who first came to Tanganyika in 1900 and possessed in colonial days the best business and mining farms. He was recently responsible for the donation of the £40,000 needed to build the new Greek Orthodox Church, which adds greatly to the prestige of the colony in poor health, he is now in his Athens home, where his son will be visiting.

DECLINE IN FOOT AND MOUTH DISEASE

THE 1954-55 outbreak of foot-and-mouth disease in Kenya of the Colony is on the decrease. Officials of the Department of Veterinary Services stated yesterday. 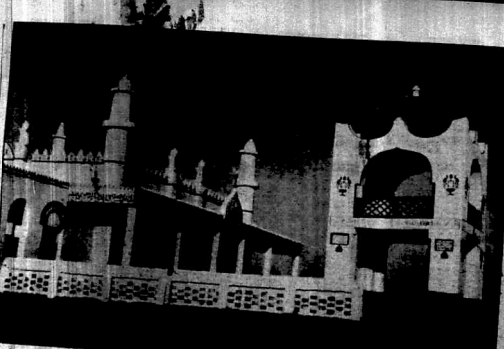

The Private Life Of The Walrus

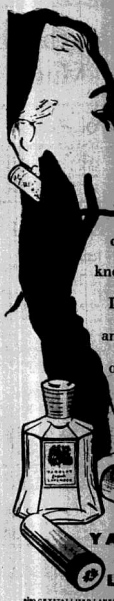
NEWSPAPER reporters thought it a joke when, a short time ago, the Department of Northern Affairs and National Development in Canada, issued an official announcement with which began: "The private life of walrus herds swimming in ice-dotted northern waters may soon be an open book to Canadian scientists."

But they soon found that the Department was in deadly earnest. The walrus is the largest of the "artiodactyl" mammals to appear in eastern Arctic regions. It is a "sea mammal" which spends a "hermit" matter. Hence, knowing on the life and behaviour of the walrus became a desideratum of importance.

Britain's Wildlife Service has just completed the first project in "tagging" walrus to trace their movements. It is the first time that has been known about the walrus but the only one known for how far they travel.
