## PRESIDENT URGES WASTAGE PROGRAMME

**Major share for Asian nations**  
**NEW FUND PROPOSED TO ASSIST DEVELOPMENT**

PRESIDENT Eisenhower has asked the U.S. Congress for £2,500,000,000 for global aid. The President did not give a programme breakdown for security and stability nor economic and military aid of the region.

His proposals do not earmark any economic assistance for the original Marshall Plan countries of Western Europe, but in addition to \$700,000,000 he set aside for the establishment of a "President Fund for Asian Development" to develop the abundant resources and the fertile lands in the region.

He said that the Asian programme would encourage private overseas investment and private enterprise abroad, foster and increase cooperative economic and emphasis loans rather than grants wherever possible.

"I consider the programme an indispensable part of a realistic and enlightened national policy," the President stated. "The fixed, unobjectionable object of that policy is a just, progressive and enduring peace."

At a meeting in London for talks with British Foreign Secretary M. P. Fisher, the President said yesterday that the United States would be ready to discuss the world problems.

Mr. Cartland revealed that at least one murder in Uganda had been directly connected with Mau Mau and a gang had been rounded up in Kisoro. "Not only was there an organised cell system, but a Mau Mau court was discovered and songs have been found for the use of Mau Mau in Uganda," he said.

A "Wage inquiry into the wages and conditions of employment of thousands in three of Kenya's major industries is to be conducted by the Wages Advisory Board at the request of the Minister for Labour, Mr. C. H. Hartwell.

# The West Yorkshire Regiment And The K.A.R.

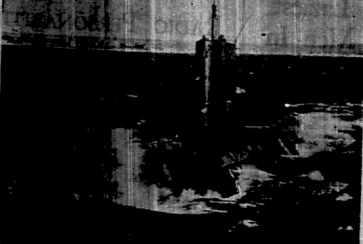

**Laziest Men In World**

AUSTRALIA'S aborigines are among the laziest human beings in the world today because of an ancient tribal law. And also because of the law the few aborigines who have achieved fame and a regular income must share their assets.

Even aboriginal artist Albert Namatjira, who is reputed to be earning more than £2,000 a year, and the well-known actor, Jeddah, Robert Uruttuwall, have been unable to escape the obligation imposed centuries ago.

"This old tribal law on food distribution requires a hunter to share their catch, and to otherwise dispose of it, specifies the manner of distribution.

Some of the natives have now hunted for decades. But today the law applies to a hunter's earnings and assets are being squandered and he is being left with nothing to show for his labor that is worth anything.

The Australian aborigine was driven from his tribal zone by the white man in most cases he quietly moved on, knowing that the food killed by the hunters would again be distributed.

This community life down the centuries has made the native a docile creature who will do only the preliminary hours to get a job and then he will work for the rest of his life while his master feeds him adequately.

The law states that a hunter may eat as much of his catch as he wishes while he is out of camp. But the moment he returns, it must be allotted in fixed portions.

**CENTURIES** ago, the elders of the "Wardandi" tribe laid down the following distribution of a kangaroo: one leg to the animal near the edge of the camp, one leg to the pack of the animal and carry it in and do the cooking.

The hunter's uncle or his wife must eat up their kangaroo. The right leg goes to the uncle (the family head), the left leg to the grandmother, one forearm to the family brother, and the other forearm hunter's mother-in-law, the tail and head.

Even when a hunter's Territory food is hard to come by and unless his food distribution law applied there would certainly be little over the dead animal.

The same law is practiced today, not only among the natives in remote parts of Arnhem Land and by aborigines on New Guinea but by some natives.

# HOMES AND GARDENS OF KENYA

By Lesley Clay

A HOUSE that has mellowed and, seemingly, taken root in the soil of Kenya is that of Colonel and Mrs. J. M. Dodington of Nairobi. Built between 1930 and 1931, with Mr. Howard Archer as the architect, it is of Nairobi stone and local Brorley tiles, standing in about five acres of gardens and vegetable plantations. When the Dodingtons first took over the land, about 100 acres of coffee had been planted and to this they have added considerably more. Much of their furniture was brought out from England, the rest purchased here, and in the past few years the house has changed considerably in appearance, both inside and out, until there are now three complete suites, a lounge, dining-room, study and office, and all-electric kitchen and laundry.

But it is the lounge, a much livelier room, that displays the family atmosphere and the sense of the past. The beautiful chaises of the suite, the curtains with their deep pattern and the three carpets harmonise restfully, great interest being given by the "Dion" "couch" upholstered in white fabric, the window, set in African mode in the Belgian Congo teak oak with sliding shutters, all in and of the delightful room.
