## WIDE AIR-GROUND SEARCH FOR TWO PLANES

**No trace of Dakota missing in Northern Rhodesia**

**E. AFRICA SWEEP OVER 27,000 SQUARE MILES**

Nearly 20 aircraft were yesterday searching for an East African Airways Dakota, missing 20 passengers and crew, planes from Salisbury were resuming their hunt for a Piper Cub, piloted by a Nairobi businessman, reported missing in Northern Rhodesia.

The full-scale ground and air search for the lost aircraft began on Wednesday afternoon when it was near Mombasa, Kilimanjaro, is one of the most extensive air searches in East Africa. 

# Federation's growth surprises experts

## AMONG FASTEST IN WORLD

THE rate of growth in the Federation was certainly among the fastest—if not the fastest—in the world. Dr. Andrew Kinnear, Economic Adviser to the Department of Operations for Europe, Africa and Australasia of the International Bank Organisation, said in Salisbury. Since Dr. Kinnear and M. Guy Tréant, an economist in the same department, arrived in the Federation a month ago, they visited Northern Rhodesia, Southern Rhodesia and Nyasaland and covered a distance of about 3,200 miles. Dr. Kinnear said that it would be some time yet before he could say whether it would be the Kenya hydro-electric scheme or the new dam at Kinnear that he looked at as more promising. The bank will continue to provide the country with the money it needs for the time being but it will decide whether it will participate.

# REVIEW OF THE WEEK'S GOLF

## Watch your step on greens

The most important of last weekend's golf events was the Karen open tournament, won by B.J. Thomson and C.D. Sykes, each of whom had done so well in the previous week at the Winston Churchill Cup at Turin. Thomson had a record of 73 and 80, for a total of 153, at Kanan, one stroke better than J. 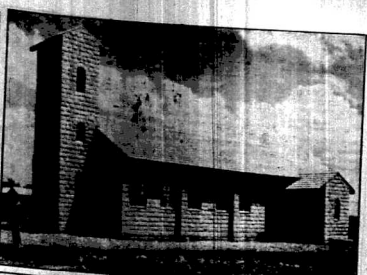

# MAU MAU LEADERS RECALCITRANT SURRENDERERS

## Breakdown of talks after 'reversal' MINISTER'S DISCLOSURE IN LEGISLATURE

A SUDDEN change took place in the attitude of Mau Mau terrorists five days before they were due to make large-scale surrenders and, when they made contact with Special Branch officers, they completely reversed the conditions which the War Council had laid down.

When Mr. Blundell, Minister without Portfolio and member of the War Council, made his disclosures in the Legislative Council this week, he said that the Government had information which gave any suggestion of the reasons for such a violent change of opinion. The Minister was giving his promised statement on the talks a few minutes after the House had adjourned. He was received in silence except for cries of "Hear, hear" when he referred to the outstanding cooperation of Special Branch officers during the contacts with terrorists. A debate on the situation opened yesterday on a motion moved by Mr. Humphrey Slade (Barbados) calling on the Government to establish and maintain a policy of law and order.

Mr. Blundell disclosed that 11 terrorist leaders from different areas were taken to the Mau Mau forest, had concealed from their followers the full details of the talks and the sudden reversal of the agreement to make large-scale surrenders.

### OFFICERS SEE GANG LEADER BY ULTIMATUM BY WAR COUNCIL

It is understood that he broke down, initially military operations were ordered to be suspended after the "reversal" in the night. The War Council issued an ultimatum to the Mau Mau leaders to surrender by a certain date. The ultimatum was rejected and the Government decided to resume military operations. The Government is now in a difficult position, as the Mau Mau leaders are now more determined than ever to continue their struggle.

### Crash victim buried on mountain side

MINISTERS IN PLANES TO CONSECRATE AREA

THE 20 passengers and crew of the Dakota wrecked on Mount Kilimanjaro were killed in a crash on the mountain side. Reports from the crash site confirm that the plane was buried on its wreckage spread over a large area. The Government has decided to consecrate the area and a service will be held there.

### Death of Mr. Algernon Gordon Doyle

Mr. Algernon Gordon Doyle, a well-known figure in the Mau Mau movement, has died. He was a member of the Mau Mau Central Executive Committee and was known for his leadership and courage. His death is a great loss to the Mau Mau movement.
