


BUT NO DATE SET FOR BILL

British Government officials are working on the draft clauses of a Bill intended to impose a tax on certain property transfers. It was reported yesterday that the House of Commons had voted to accept the bill.

Similar clauses, and, reportedly, to bring in a measure of control over the movement of capital assets, were introduced earlier this year by the Labour government.

Opposition members, however, insisted on a clause which would have imposed a broad-based stamp duty on financial instruments.

The bill was eventually withdrawn.

ALWAYS A FUTURE FOR SODA FACTORY

REGARDLESS of parties in power, the chairman of I.C.I. Mr. S. P. Cheshire, believes that the future of the industry is secure.

I.C.I. was the only company to expand its operations where there was a fall in consumption.

It is probable that the main bulk of Kenya's soda production will continue to be in operation to provide an export market.

At a reception at the C.M.C. headquarters in Nairobi last night, Mr. Cheshire said that I.C.I. had no intention to leave Kenya, and it should be given a long-term lease with a break clause.

Slump in Nairobi's building plans deplored

MR. BLOCK URGES: LOOK TO THE FUTURE

The chairman of the Town Planning Committee, Mr. E. N. Sherriff, last night deplored Nairobi's "stagnant" building developments.

At a Nairobi City Council meeting he said that in the middle of 1961 the grants of building plans submitted for approval by the town to rise "most encouragingly" after categorised returns had been made indicating that land titles would be required.

However, later pronouncements by "certain politicians" had soon put a stop to this welcome return of confidence.

In the year of building plans approved for private development between January and December 1961, £25,116,230. In the same period of 1960, it was £31,37,651.

For the corresponding period of 1959, the value had dropped to £1,747,821.

REVENUE DROPS

Annual plans approved had dropped from 1,771 in the first 10 months of 1960, to 600 in the 1961 period and subdivision schemes submitted had fallen from 1,200 to 266. Total planning fees in the three years periods were £650, £300 and £210 respectively.

Paying tribute to the work of members of the town planning committee, Mr. Sherriff said he was only sorry that the members had not been able to keep their plans into the mind and most beautiful in Africa.

In his speech, the Mayor, Ald. H. G. Davies, who was present, expressed the need for the future. The city was fortunate to have a master plan to guide the rapid post-war development, not the City Valuer's planning, he said.

Mr. Davies said that a reasonable amount was now being spent on roads and embankments which had embarked on a major survey.

This involved all aspects of city development, land use and town planning, he said. The survey was to be carried out for densities, school premises, water supplies, population surveys and other factors.

Referring to the Beaufort area, Mr. Davies said that perhaps it was a fact that the city could not yet provide for all its needs.

Regarding the industrial area, he said that as a result of the survey, it was felt that there would be no problem in providing for essential industries.

Referring to the Postmaster General's speech, Mr. Davies said an estimated expenditure of more than £100 million was planned for roads and telecommunications, including the new airport at Nairobi.

Mr. Davies said that the new airport would be a great boon to the country.




