

Ghana White Paper PLOT TO MURDER DR. NKURUM

Togo accused of helping coup plan

THE Ghana Government last night accused leaders of the opposition United Party and members of the ruling Convention People's Party of taking oaths to assassinate President Nkrumah, and plotting to create chaos and confusion in Ghana and bring about an Army coup d'etat.

A White Paper published to explain October's events — mostly of U.P. leaders and their women to some of the country's most prominent politicians and to President Sylvanus Olympio of neighbouring Togoland were involved in the conspiracy.

The White Paper said the plotters counted on the aid of the British officers then holding commands in the Ghana Army. It attacked foreign correspondents in the London newspaper, The Times.

Mr. Joe Appiah, the U.P. Member of Parliament whose wife, Peggy, is the daughter of the late Sir Stafford Cripps, was accused of being one of the organisers of the strikes which broke out in Western Ghana in September during President Nkrumah's Eastern tour.

First phase of plot

Dr. J. B. Danquah, veteran U.P. leader, was said to have given funds to market women in the ports of Sekondi and Takoradi and to buy the more of the strike movement — to buy guns and distribute it to strikers.

The White Paper said the first phase of the plot was by leaders of the United Party, joined by some of the more unprincipled of the self-styled members of the C.P.P. Mr. K. K. Quaidoo, a C.P.P. member and former Minister, was a conspirator.

Phase two of the plot, according to the White Paper, was to have been a "campaign of violence" designed to "create chaos and confusion".

"This was originally to be carried out by the United Party and before it was abandoned, it was to be carried out by the C.P.P. group and arrested about 30 strikers after the arrests early in October, Dr. C. Dr. Quaidoo's meeting was held in the house of President Nkrumah, at which a list of names was determined upon and the names of the plotters were written down. The White Paper said it had already had copies of the list in its possession.

"The names had been given to the C.P.P. group and arrested about 30 strikers after the arrests early in October, Dr. C. A. Busia, former leader of the organisation which was known as the "United Party" in London.

Bomb explosions

At the meeting in President Nkrumah's house, Dr. Busia announced that he had arranged that the C.P.P. group should be arrested in the U.S. where they were to be given financial support.

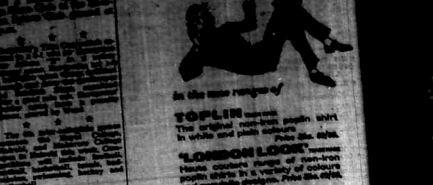

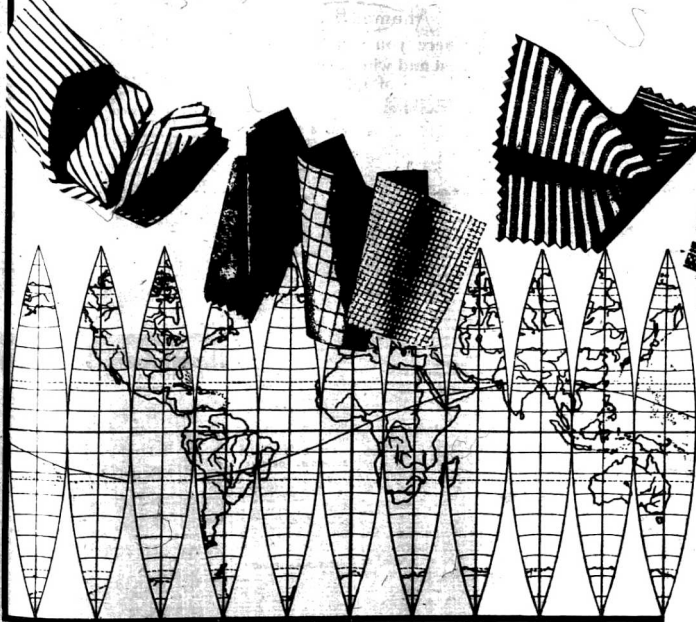

The Union Miniere said the hospital was at Shinkolobwe, near Jadotville. The maternity ward was hit and several women were evacuated. A child who had gone to see his mother in the maternity ward was killed.

The company report said two young children were seriously wounded in the attack and two other children killed. There was a big Red Cross sign on the hospital. One ward was completely destroyed but it was empty at the time.

Other towns strafed

The Union Miniere also said the U.N. aircraft strafed eight towns in the Jadotville area, attacking the Post office and railway in Jadotville itself.

A U. N. Canberra bomber made two swoops over Elisabethville railway station about noon. Katangese troops fired away vainly with machine-guns and rifles.

An mortar fire continued throughout Elisabethville. A big anti-aircraft search light was operating in the town.

Mr. Nzondo, who is a member of the Katanga Government, said he was in Elisabethville yesterday. He said he was being protected by the U.N. troops.

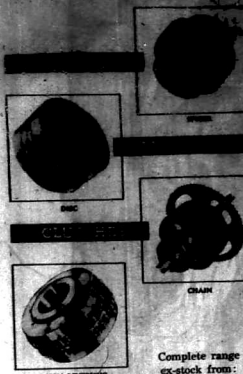

Queen has a colorful chill

Queen Elizabeth has a feverish chill and is staying in her room at Buckingham Palace. It was officially announced yesterday.

The Queen cancelled her left party engagements yesterday. They included the Prince of Wales, the American Ambassador, the 10,000-member band of West Africa and the first of the 100-hour mourning period in the heart of the African continent.

The queen left yesterday at London Castle with her daughter Princess Anne, wearing a purple riding habit in Windsor Great Park.

Dr. Verwoerd plans coloured parliament

The South African Prime Minister, Dr. Verwoerd yesterday outlined a ten-year plan for the country's 1,600,000 population, including "using their own affairs through a 'Coloured Parliament'."

Addressing the Council of Coloured Affairs in Cape Town, he referred to a separate house, which he said would be "grouped with the white parliament."

He hoped to see colored towns with their own local authorities established within a year.

He said he envisaged a governing council to look after the interests of colored people throughout the country. It would have an executive of 100 members with functions similar to those of Ministers—such as agriculture, local government, education, and social services such as health.

The transfer of colored affairs to the colored parliament would be a "step towards the final solution of the color question."

He thought that in five years they could get far with the framework and in ten years it could be functioning freely.

British East Africa Co. might claim to have built the first railway in East Africa because in 1896 that company decided to build a 211-mile gauge railway (named the Central African Railway) inland from Mombasa. Eight miles from Mombasa, British engineers could not get company money from the British Government and the line had to be abandoned.

Instead Mr. (later Sir George) Whitehouse, the author of the report, which was dated January, 1902, wrote of the "rapid advance" that had been made in completing communications between the Coast and the Lake.

More than 150 miles of road had been built since the first railway arrived in May 1896, and the end of that year 12 miles of railway had been built. The 12 miles to Voi had been finished and opened for traffic on May 1899, the railway reaching Nairobi.

WASHED AWAY

Construction of the railway began in 1893 but was beset with all kinds of difficulties. The country was virtually unknown, inhabitable and, at that time, unhealthy.

All work had to be done by hand and since labour could not be found locally it had to be brought from India. It was the main artery of the people of India who came over to build the Uganda Railway.

DECISION TAKEN

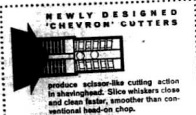

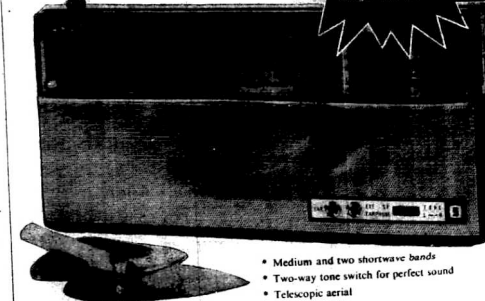
