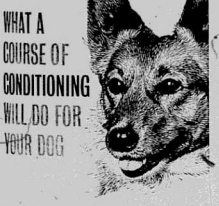

The five principles are — the establishment in a written constitution of the basic human freedoms, land and property rights shall be paid for any land acquired by the Government for public use; there shall be any future Government for public cooperation between economic, political and social co-operation between all the peoples; there shall be a balanced development of education, health and other services, an independent judiciary and fair and just administration of the country at all levels.

## Successful experiments made in Europe to 'breed back' extinct species of wild life

IN Africa there is alarm lest man should destroy the wild life that is part of his heritage. In Europe that process has been going on for centuries. The last wild aurochs, ancestor of our domestic cattle, died in Poland in 1927. The bison, or European wild horse, became extinct in 1873. The other day I was able to photograph herds of both animals.

Dr. Heinz Heck founder of the Tierpark Hellabrunn, near Munich, who has patiently bred them back in co-operation with his brother, Dr. Lutz Heck, until recently director of the Berlin Zoo and now retired.

These joint achievements have been possible thanks to the British public. Dr. Heinz Heck has given me a letter which tells me how it was done.

The principle on which Dr. Heck worked was that if a wild animal has given up by selective breeding to domesticated breeds, then the heritable constitution must be preserved within these breeds, so essential factors being found in one breed, a second in another breed, and so on.

## CAREFUL PLAN

They thought if they associated a collection of primitive domestic breeds, such as those of the Iberian Peninsula, with the characteristics of the wild ancestor, and then embarked on a carefully planned breeding programme, they would eventually succeed in re-creating the primitive factors in one strain.

They would then try to do all the things which the wild ancestor and his herd did. In this way they would be able to produce a herd which would be indistinguishable from the wild ancestor.

Dr. Heinz Heck's first experiments were directed at breeding back the aurochs. With the aid of a collection of primitive domestic breeds, he was able to find in it an animal which was indistinguishable from the wild ancestor.

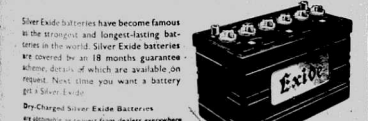

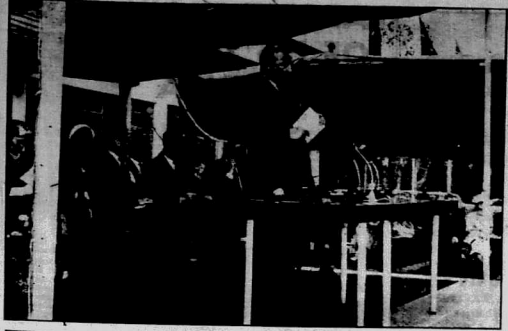
# Three Governors attend opening of school extensions

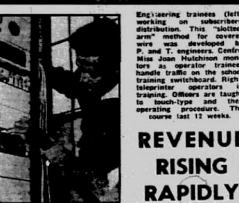

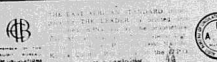

**S**OME artificial fertilisers will dissolve in water as readily as sugar. These are the ones which act quickly on plants in general, and it should also be noted that these are the ones which are most likely to be washed out by rain.

It will be seen that artificial fertilisers can be most useful in restoring quickly a plant which is at a lower level in soil than it occupies at the time of application.

**Artificial fertilisers** are divided into various groups which apply the term in a general plant chemical sense. **Macronutrients:** These are the elements of soda, and both constitute nitrogen to the soil. This chemical element has a marked effect on leaf and stem growth and contributes little to fruit formation and ripening process.

Great growth is greatly encouraged by its use, but too much addition leads to lack of resistance to disease.

Both should be used at a maximum rate of 50 a square yard of ground. **Micro-nutrients:** Both chemicals dissolve in water and can be easily spread evenly by dispersing in water and applying by a spray or watering can. Green vegetables such as cabbage, spinach, etc. benefit greatly from a fertilizer.

**Potash fertilizers:** Available under various names are potassium chloride, potassium sulfate, potassium nitrate, etc. These contain a fair proportion of potash.

This element greatly assists plants in disease-resistance.

# TEAM FIGHTS TO KEEP NAIROBI A HEALTHY CITY

By Cliff Dixon

Their unrelenting effort and they laboratory in the Nairobi City Hall, a team of eight health and food inspectors, under the leadership of the Chief Health Inspector, Mr. H. T. Woodley, are waging a campaign to keep the City's food supply free from contamination and its population safe from sickness and possible death from disease.

In the first six months of this year 53,600 lbs of foodstuffs were condemned and 100 offenders and 43 against people for other food offences.

Each of this condemned food consisted of tinned goods which had "blown", meat and fish which had decomposed, vermin-infested biscuits, cereals, potato and other items, tinned and spaced foods and other stock contaminated by dirt and such as Nairobi's, and that there is an enormous reserve of disease which is ready to break through at any moment in a community.

During the past 13 years Mr. Woodley and his team have maintained the highest standards of health and food inspection in Kenya, keeping down disease outbreaks to a level lower than that experienced in most British towns of similar size, despite the hardships of Kenya's warmer climate.

### ALWAYS BUSY

The two food inspectors alone cover several hundred miles each month keeping an eye on the city's 85 food factories, 224 eating houses, restaurants, and the city's food stores, grocers, refreshment, delicatessen and fishmongery shops.

Their duties cover both the inspection and licensing of premises, including bakeries, dairies, flour mills and internal water and sewerage factories. Not that they have always been looking for work. The telephone in their office is usually dead over its requested lines for them to examine food which has been delivered in a poor condition or which has deteriorated while in storage, from insurance companies, to

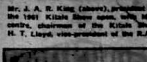
