More arrests in New Delhi

MARY officials of Maharashtra—the extreme Hindu organization to which Mahatma Gandhi's alleged assassin, Nathuram Godse, Maharashtra Congress, announced his aim in private armies and Indian movements have been the Government for its father, the prophet Gandhi. 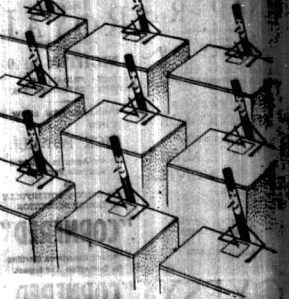

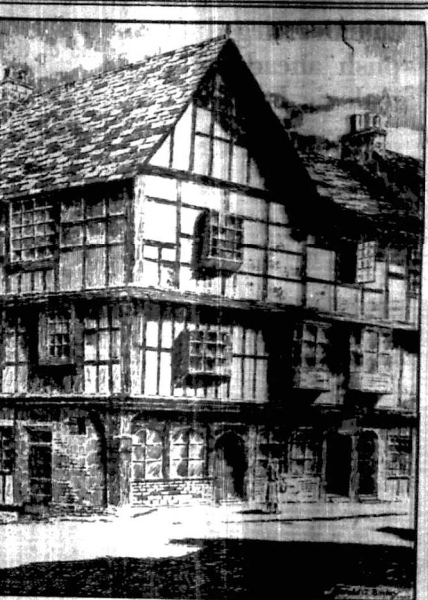

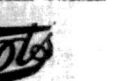

WHAT are these Health Centres for the provision of which Kenya is to cost £250,000 from the Colonial Development and Welfare Funds?

There are two answers. In its simplest form a health centre may be merely an out-patient department with a staff member—just the emphasis is on the prevention of sickness and the promotion of better health rather than the curing of illness.

In its most elaborate development it may be a unit of doctors, nurses, dentists, sanitary inspectors and the like. But the underlying motive will be the same—stopping the occurrence of sickness and making the root cause of illness the first object of attack.

The size and form of the centre depends largely upon the community to which it is to be attached.

In South Africa the health centres referred to by the National Government are known as health centres. This definition is also used in Kenya.

Britain's first atom bomb 'no dud'

Britain's first atomic bomb, exploded at 11.02 a.m. on February 8, 1952, at the Aldermaston test site, was a success. The test was conducted by the Atomic Energy Research Establishment, which is a part of the Ministry of Defence. The bomb was a 'Fat Man' type, and it exploded at an altitude of about 1,500 feet. The explosion was seen from a distance of about 10 miles. The test was a success because the bomb exploded as intended, and it was not a dud. This is a significant achievement for Britain, as it shows that the country has the capability to produce and use atomic weapons.

'PULL TOGETHER—OR TAKE THE CONSEQUENCES'

SIR STAFFORD CRIPPS, Britain's Chancellor of the Exchequer, called for the passing of wages and profits in a spirit of agreement as a national emergency when he bluntly warned, "Britain must either pull together or be forced into methods of totalitarian control."

He continued: "It is necessary for us to survive in this country the minority must be prepared to make sacrifices and to make sacrifices for the good of the whole. Otherwise someone will be called upon to force us to comply as the only alternative to disaster."

He said those doctors who are protesting against their position under the new health scheme of being one of certain and opinions might be proved to be the doctors of the future. The world that we can afford to run any risks in our own domestic structure."

Sir Stafford, who on Friday urged Britons to realize "that the whole future of our country hangs in the balance," gave an extensive briefing on just what the nation had to face.

"If we try and use potential shortages of labour and materials to step up our individual personal incomes we shall bring the whole system crashing down about our ears."

Emphasizing the need to keep costs and prices low so that Britain can afford to add abroad to her exports, Sir Stafford said: "The position has become more and more serious. It is not only that we are having to pay for our imports but also that we are having to pay for our exports. This is a very serious situation and we must do something about it."

"Unless we can keep those prices down we shall soon find that we cannot sell the volume of goods we must sell if we are to pay for our imports with our own materials. We must therefore keep our prices down and we must do this by cutting our costs and by increasing our productivity. This is a very difficult task, but it is one that we must undertake if we are to survive in this world of competition."

Britain is expected to say 'No'

Partition plan preserves Jerusalem as an open city

ITS GOVERNOR TO PROTECT SHRINES, ADMIT PILGRIMS

THE "open city" provisions in the draft statute for the international regime of the City of Jerusalem published yesterday are to be placed before the Trustees Council of the United Nations by its special working committee in five days time—the U.N.O. guarantee of the territorial integrity of the city.

Demarcation of the Holy City is provided for as well as the protection of holy places there by means of new walls and the free entry to the city of citizens from other parts of Palestine and of Palestine and foreign pilgrims and visitors.

In the adjacent areas the statute proposes to safeguard both Arab and Jewish cultural traditions and languages.

The working committee's draft covers 29 pages and, briefly, the principal provisions are:

No military formations allowed

ONE: The United Nations will guarantee the territorial integrity of the city and the maintenance of the special international character of the city.

TWO: The city itself will be demarcated with no "paramilitary" formations.

THREE: The Governor will be appointed for a three-year term, which can be extended if necessary, and he will be elected by the Trustees Council. No resident of the city or of the Arab or Jewish state will be eligible. The Governor will have executive authority, subject only to the instructions of the Trustees Council and will also have powers for the maintenance and protection of holy places elsewhere in Palestine.

FOUR: Jerusalem's Legislative Council will consist of a single chamber of the elected citizens of Jerusalem over 18 years of age. Citizens, by the definition of the statute, will not include aliens present simply for citizenship in the Arab state or the Jewish state.

FIVE: Several alternative proposals for the composition of the Legislative Council are included in the draft statute. The decision of the Trustees Council.
