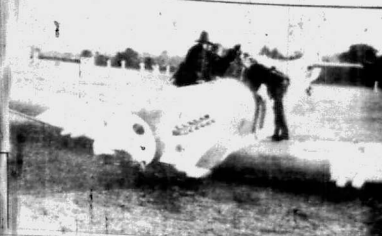


ROUGH LANDING FOR LAST SPITFIRE

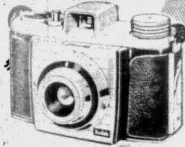

THE KRUSHCHEVS IN AMERICA

THE VISIT of Nikita Khrushchev to America has been a landmark event in the history of the Cold War. The Premier's arrival in New York on September 15th, 1959, was greeted with a mixture of curiosity and skepticism. The American people were eager to see the man who had been the chief spokesman for the Soviet Union for over a decade.

Khrushchev's visit was not without incident. He was met at the airport by a large crowd of people, many of whom were shouting and waving. The Premier's car was surrounded by a throng of reporters and photographers. He was seen to be in good spirits and to be enjoying his stay in America.

UNANIMOUS SUPPORT PREDICTED

Aid plan likely to be approved

AUTHORITATIVE sources predicted that a United States proposal to create an international Development Association for aiding under-developed countries, officially put forward at the September World Bank meeting in Washington yesterday, would be unanimously adopted.

The proposed association, which would be affiliated to the World Bank, is expected to have an authorized capital of about \$300,000,000. Members would pay half of their subscriptions initially and the remainder in equal instalments over five years.

Indian map challenges Red claim

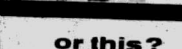

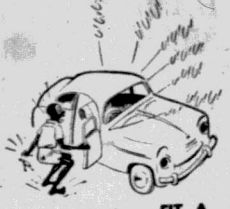

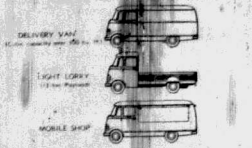
