SUDAN'S PRIME MINISTER OUSTED

Heavy defeat after vote of censure

Prime Minister of the Sudan, Mr. Mahgoub, resigned yesterday after being heavily defeated in a Constituent Assembly vote of censure.

Almost immediately the Supreme State Council President, Mr. al Azahari, who accepted the resignation, began contact with Saeed Sadek al Manshi, the president of Mr. Mahgoub's Umma Party, on the formation of a new Cabinet.

It was a move by the Umma National Front—a major coalition partner along with the National Front—to replace Mr. Mahgoub by the young party president who worked off the censure motion.

In one of the shortest sessions of the Assembly, Mr. Mahgoub was defeated by 128 votes to 30, mainly on the basis of Coalition Party members, including two of his own Cabinet Ministers.

It seemed to hang in the air for a crisis over the Government's leadership which had simmered for months in the interim. Mr. Mahgoub took office in June last year. He had the support of the Umma Party and the National Front.

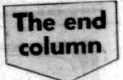

LIBERATION OF S.W. AFRICA

KENYA IS DUTIFULLY TAKING the initiative against the injustice of the ruling given by the Court of South West Africa. During the week ending the House of Representatives, Mr. Ngũga described the court as the International Court of Justice and after six years of daily-battering, this bench of eminent States admitted responsibility, whereas previously the side effect of so-called peace treaties and of immediate exhibition made a mockery of Justice and the application of international law.

The court refused to proceed to the examination of the status and administration of Africa, and the mandate by South Africa from the former League of Nations, recognised by the United Nations. Consequently, there is much to be congratulated on taking up a new approach. Mr. Ngũga is seeking to bring before the court directly administered by the UN for the remainder of the period for the UN administration of Africa. 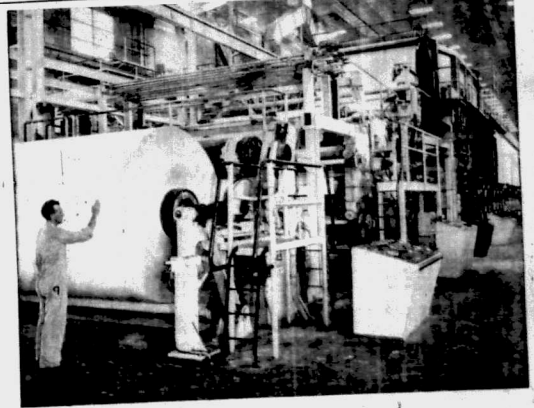

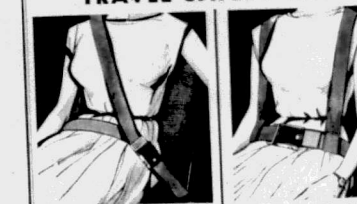

SPORT—AND SOCCER

EVEN ENGLAND'S THRILLING victory over West Germany in the final of the World Soccer Cup competition cannot remove the nasty taste left by the disastrous happenings in several of the previous matches. The 1966 competition will surely go down in soccer history as the year when "football" was "communistically killed" and "sportiness" in football.

Ruffianly displays of players on the field and the insulting reactions in front of the boisterous crowds are all the more because of the tremendous interest in the 400,000,000 people in the four quarters of the globe who followed the game. In the 1966 competition, 10,000 spectators turned up at Wembley.

What a morning it must have been for the two teams played on Wednesday. Whatever the embittered opponents who were involved in the previous matches may say, there is no doubt the best team won.

No doubt, too, that West Germany produced worthy rivals who not only played good football, but played the game as well. Where more than half said about some of the competition's reporters and their newspapers back home.

For example, our Buenos Aires evening paper described the final as a farce, another labelled the "winners lucky gambler" and a third, having withdrawn its correspondent, said the competition had "ceased to be a sporting contest" because of the "unpleasantness of the game." We know some who helped it become that way. Argentina, for example, was booed out by England on the line, of course, were knocked out by England in the quarter-final battle of Wembley. If the competition degenerated into a competition of bribery, Argentina can claim some of the discredit. So can West Germany.

An Italian Communist journal distinguished itself by remarking that "England's achievement was won through sink into corruption" and proceeded to libel four referees who supposedly helped England's success. Somewhat indignantly, the paper acknowledged England's superiority as proving the "lie" could have done without many of the helping hands received in earlier rounds.

On their way to the top, the Englishmen gave classic displays of football. So did the West German and, for their behavior, the Russians and the Portuguese. Even that President's award of the Silver Laurel medal to the country's highest sporting honor.

England ran out convincing champions. But both she and Portugal played the game as if it were a Cup Final. The operators will never forget, which is what matters most, "though it is to have the victory in a Cup Final, they play the game when politics and commercialism enter, preventing any day from being played just for the sake of playing."

THREATS to national survival

TWICE IN A WEEK, African troops have murdered first in the Congo and then in Nigeria, proving military government is no guarantee of national stability.

Katanga's troops, aided by mercenaries, invaded the Congo. Admittedly, their rising is not thought to have political aims. The troops would have done without pay and permission to return to Katanga, but their revolt reveals a dangerous uncertainty in their allegiance to the State.

Major-General Irons was sworn in Sudan when elements of the Nigerian army mutinied. He is assumed power after a military coup in January, he has been trying desperately to smooth out tribal differences and has wiped out the federal system under which tribalist defined regions had their own Governments.

Disturbances have occurred in the predominantly Muslim North. There is no sign of a military coup. In the absence of an official explanation, unconfirmed reports suggest Hausa officers in the army remained loyal to the military Government.

The comment of the *Top Drive*, in Lyons, is well worth noting in all African States where there is any trouble. "Whatever the political wealth of a country may be, whatever may be its progress towards economic development, that country will not prosper if its progress and even its survival to internal peace and to its national unity."
