

## EIGHT KIKUYU JAILED FOR OATH ACTIVITY

Three years for administrator

By our Correspondent  
EIGHT Kikuyu were sentenced this week in the Magistrate's Court at Nyeri for illegal oath activity in the Maro Maro area on April 1 this year.

Joseph Njoroge, 25, Karuri, was sentenced to three years' hard labour for administering the oath to Karuki, Karuki, Njeru, Wachira, Kenyatta, Wairimu, and Gikungo Wakiru each received three years' hard labour for voluntarily taking the oath.

A woman, Nyarusi, w/o. Wairimu, was sentenced to three years' simple imprisonment for the same voluntary taking.

The Magistrate, Mr. M. O. Mwaura, who had been completely satisfied with the evidence adduced by the two witnesses and he had no difficulty in convicting the accused.

### Dangerous

Addressing the court before sentence, Mr. G. M. Henderson, defence in the scaffold case, said that in the opinion of the police that the accused had committed a thoroughly dangerous act.



He has served the Creameries for 20 years.

As with most agricultural developments of the major sort, the growth of the dairying industry has come with the urgent backing of the late Lord Delamere. The results of Lord Delamere's work are well known. Lord Delamere said that Kenya's development was due to the fact that the Kenyan farmer had adopted mixed farming. His confidence


today is widely recognized that Kenya's future lies in its farms and that agriculture is likely to continue in this position for many years to come. The dairy position for many years has been of great importance to every


