Kenya statement

THE OBJECTIVES—AND HOW THEIR FULFILMENT IS SOUGHT

It is a generally accepted political principle that a Government cannot commit its successors in office by policy or promise or declarations of policy. Statements of policy, therefore, do no more than state the policy which the Government of the day proposes to follow. It is able to do so in contemporary conditions in Kenya dependent upon its securing the greatest possible measure of agreement and support in the Legislative Council, even though, in the technical sense, it is not responsible to the Legislative Council; that is to say, that it is not obliged to resign—in fact, unable to resign—on account of an adverse vote in the Legislature.

It is in these general observations in mind that the Government issues the following Statement of its policy:

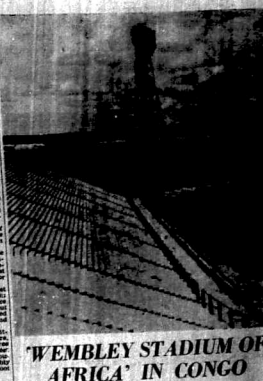

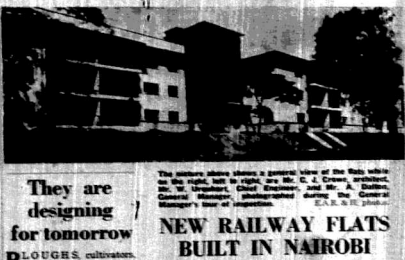

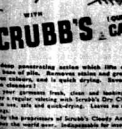

India Uses The Sun

By Rawley Knox

HARNESSING the energy of the sun, on which research was recently reported from the London Science College of Science and Technology, has been the imagination of men in India where there is enough sunlight to matter. India is a province of Rajasthan, only one-tenth of the world's territory, receives, it is estimated, enough sunshine to provide power for the whole world.

I shall myself be solar cooking over 20 years ago," said Dr. Krishna, Scientific Adviser to the Indian High Commission in London, the other day.

Premier's lead

LALU Prasad, Mr. Nehru, Indian Prime Minister, had a solar oven installed in his official residence in Delhi. In his Physical Laboratory, where research on solar power is being conducted under a 28-year-old American scientist, S. L. Ghai, there stands a solar oven which was used by the present President, Dr. Rajendra Prasad, while he was suffering from an ailment in the Indian hills.

Already India can turn out a substantial amount of solar power of about 12 kw. which would avoid the great waste of animal manure now used as fuel, and would also avoid the serious pollution of small Indian homes near the great cities.

Turbine engines

RESEARCH is being carried out on the use of turbine engines, which could develop the equivalent of 100 turbines, to drive the bearings and pumping machines which now burn imported oil in almost every Indian village, and even by replacing bulb-power by drawing the steam from a stationary engine.

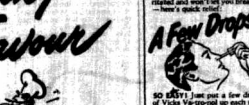

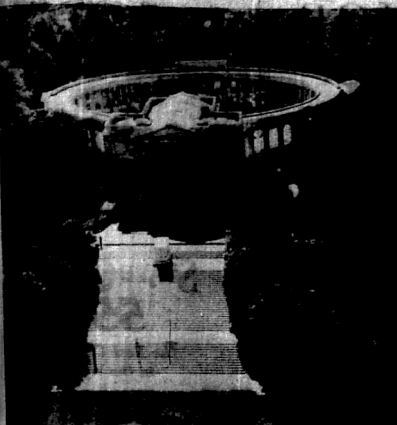
