DEBATE ON YALU RIVER RAIDS

Consultation demanded WE BACK OUR ALLIES, SAYS MR. EDEN: ATTACKS GO ON

MR. ANTHONY EDEN, Foreign Secretary, told the House of Commons on Wednesday that the British had not been consulted before the Korean Yalu River border attacks on the North. But Mr. Eden, speaking for the Government, said emergency details on the Government's view of "how that the decision has been taken" was quick to act, "but that we were not consulted" — although he did not say so.

It is understood that Mr. Eden yesterday told Mr. Denis Austin, American Secretary of State, at present in London, that Britain wants to be consulted — and Mr. Austin has agreed to this. He was reported to have asked Mr. Eden to keep up his "power" raids on North Korea, but Mr. Eden said that American aircraft were not to be used on Wednesday and continuing details.

Opening the Opposition leader Mr. Clement Attlee summed up London feeling by describing the Yalu River raids as "a mistake in psychology." Mr. Attlee added: "I think we should have the chance of an armistice, and may find a way out of this. I am not a pacifist, but I am a realist."

DEBATE ON YALU RIVER RAIDS

Consultation demanded WE BACK OUR ALLIES, SAYS MR. EDEN: ATTACKS GO ON

MR. ARTHUR EDEN, Foreign Secretary, told the House of Commons on Wednesday that he regretted that Britain had not been consulted before American aircraft launched their devastating attacks on the North Yalu River. He said that the Government is at an emergency debate on the bombings, was quick to add that the coalition has been taken—although not necessary we were not consulted—we give our Allies full support in it.

It is understood that Mr. Eden yesterday told Mr. Dean Acheson, American Secretary of State, at present in London, that Britain would be consulted—and not merely be told afterwards. He was reported to have asked Mr. Acheson for an assurance on future consultation.

Meanwhile, cables from Korea say that American aircraft are keeping up their "power" raids on North Korea, carrying on 500 sorties on Wednesday and continuing yesterday to blast the Communist battle lines.

Opening the Commons Government papers to limit the conflict to Korea and get a fair and reasonable armistice, was further limited by the American law which Korea, says a military target.

The raids on the river were part of an "impressive military plan to try to infiltrate Communist forces into the area."

Mr. Acheson declared: "I think we have the chance of an armistice and may lead to a dangerous new phase in the East, that happens, no one knows where it may go."

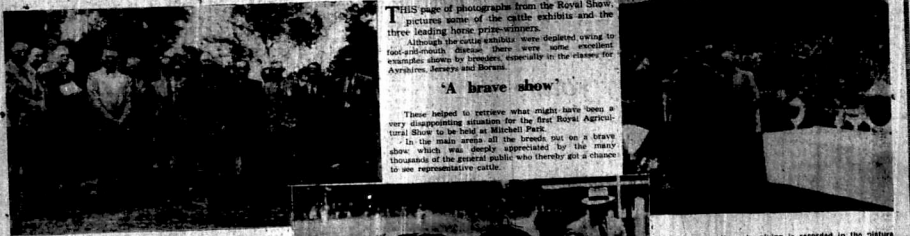

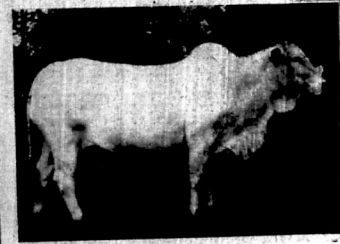

NURSERY SCHOOLS AND CULTURAL ENVIRONMENT

This article is extracted from a story recently written for Unesco by Maria Montessori, one of the world's greatest educators, who died in Italy in Holland at the age of 81

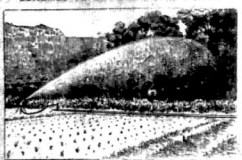

THE STORY OF THE KENYA POLICE RESERVE

By Assistant Superintendent J. S. RITCHIE, Provincial Staff Officer, K.P.R.

THE post-war years found the Civil and Police authorities in most countries of the world pre-occupied with finding a solution to the rising incidence of crime and other anti-social evils which the aftermath of war had imposed on society.

Kenya, in common with those countries, was likewise pre-occupied. Added to this, throughout the world manifested itself in certain provinces of the Colony, and the police disintegrated among the people, by the most serious of public evils, i.e., the spread of the public conscience to the need for public opinion urged further increase in the situation was by no means remote, and although a security force of the Colony. To meet these changing conditions the idea was conceived of raising a non-subsidiary force of volunteer police and on August 30, 1942, the Kenya Police Reserve was created by Ordinance.

Present strength

The strength of the Force today is 3,801 which represents only a nominal figure below establishment and the racial composition consists of European, Asian, Arab and African.

Except for a small administrative staff every officer and the common good confers a dignity on the Force peculiarly worthy of its title.

The statutory provisions relating to the Force are contained in the Kenya Police Reserve Ordinance, 1942. The present arrangement is couched in terms so simple in conception as to ensure the employment of the Reserve in the Colony with the utmost facility, and without fear of insurrection.

Both of these Forces were somewhat conservative in outlook and performance but, nevertheless,

gave room service to the Colony. Undoubtedly much of the experience gained in the management of those Forces was built into the fabric of the Reserve and conditioned it earlier than would normally have been the case to play, if necessary, rather than as a necessity, a role of only subsidiary importance.
