More work on roads urged by farmers

\$75,000,000 A YEAR BEING SPENT

Approximately half the amount of road work in the United States is done in the rural areas, according to a report issued by the Federal Highway Administration last week. The report states that the Federal Government spends about \$75,000,000 a year on rural roads, which is about 50 percent of the total amount spent on roads in the country.

The report also points out that the rural areas are in need of more road work, particularly in the mountain and hilly regions. It suggests that the Federal Government should increase its spending on rural roads to help improve the transportation system in these areas.

WASHINGTON SOAP IS FREED

Control on local products

The price of locally produced laundry soap has been decreased by the Federal Trade Commission, which has ruled that the Government's control on local products is no longer justified.

CLOSER SETTLEMENT IN RIFT VALLEY

Another estate to be subdivided

With the purchase of approximately 21,000 acres of land on the Mau Escarpment at the beginning of the Rift Valley becomes less of a political ideal and more of an accomplished fact. Soon, nearly 70 farms which will be farming on land only two or three years ago were created by the fourth estate to be subdivided in the last few years.

The intention

It is in the Settlement Board's intention to settle as many farmers as possible on the land based on the potential divisions. An aerial photograph of the land is being made, and contour maps are to be prepared on the productive qualities of each portion. It is anticipated that the maps will show that it will be possible to divide the farm into 20 and 30 acre units, and retain about 5,000 acres of the Mau forest.

The Board will have a resident agent in the area and will be responsible for the development of the district, the construction of roads, the re-planting of the Mau forest, the development of water supplies from boreholes, and the development of the area.

NEW WARNING FOR BRITONS

Far-reaching measures TO BE SURVEYED BEFORE END OF COMMONS RECESS

Prime Minister of Great Britain, Mr. Winston Churchill, has told the House of Commons that "very grave and far-reaching measures" affecting the British national life—both domestic and defensive—would be discussed in a two-day debate before the summer recess of Parliament which is expected to take place at the close of the month.

Mr. Douglas Jay (Labour) had asked for a statement on Government policy to give exports higher priority than defence.

Mr. Churchill replied that the relationship of exports and defence requirements would be dealt with in the forthcoming debate on economic matters.

Mr. Jay asked if Mr. Churchill agreed with the statement in Government (Chancellor the Deputy of Lancaster and Minister of Materials) last week that exports were more vital than defence—was this a case of mere common sense in the Government?

Mr. Churchill: "The general rule as a guiding principle that may be assumed by the Labour opposition is that complete agreement arises among members of the Government."

Mr. Emanuel Shinwell, a member of the United States Air Force, said that the defence programme was "a higher rate than ever before." "There are plenty of cooks and crannies in the North Atlantic going to cut."

Mr. Churchill: "The House is going to be informed of the various resources being taken in all fields in order to make sure that we get our own share and live on our own terms and exports—and not to pay our own share and live on the terms of others."

Mr. Shinwell—saying that was very interesting—asked if Mr. Churchill would not agree that defence expenditure was linked with economic requirements and exports were there to be a reduction in defence expenditure, which might be justified, unless it should be informed, mainly from the matter of an economic deficit.
