



Jane Irving tries to discover KENYA'S NATIONAL FLOWER

ENGLAND has an undisputed claim to the rose and France has always boasted her fleur-de-lis. Scotland has the thistle and Ireland the shamrock. But what do we look upon as Kenya's national flower?

This week's picture page invites YOU to decide. I contacted two of our best-known botanical experts on the question and they—Dr. A. J. Jac-Blaik and Mr. F. H. O. Bally—selected eight from the many exotic and beautiful flowers which grow in Kenya as the most likely candidates for the honour. Six of them are illustrated.

It may be that someone has other ideas but it should be borne in mind that whenever you choose the flower should be indigenous to the Colony.

It is perhaps significant that this flower was chosen by Dr. Jac-Blaik, for the cover of the book, *Gardening in East Africa*, which he edited. It was chosen, too, by the Kenya Horticultural Society as the emblem for its badge for life members. Here Jane's the Queen chose the flower in presidential brown form.

Scrubland Cameroons is just another way of saying Mandi Plant before winter. This needs an introduction to Kenya people who receive no chance of red flowers about our dry and dusty roads. They appear at a height of 40 feet or more on the Mount Kenya. They are very remarkable for their large size and containing more than for their graceful design or proportions. The tree grows in tropical and West Africa as well as in Kenya and run stand up to drought.


Only one of the eight flowers is indigenous to Kenya. It is *Philippia* (top right). Children call it "Jimmy" though the large terminal and pink, upright inflorescence bears a striking resemblance to the comb which the bird uses for its nest. It is seen in the picture below.

More attention than its competitors is the *Palmsia Lily* or *Crisium Kiania*. One of our best-known flowers, it is a large white red-tipped drooping flower and is widely distributed in tropical Africa, from the coast to the highlands. There are many species of the *Crisium* in Kenya, but the *Kiania* is the most popular.

A flower with small habits is the *Bardian Dance* or *Andalucia Cordia*, top left. Whichever it falls, the *Dance* comes to life. A delicate pure white and sweet-scented flower. It is a Mexican tree plant and is found in grasslands, flourishing particularly in the Ngong Hills.

And what of the many others and creepers indigenous to Kenya? The number of which there are many varieties. For instance, the *Andalucia* have included in their selection of eight flowers the *Chrysom* because it is the most common. It is like the highest height and has a bright orange flower rather like a *Chrysom* in design. It is seen below left.



Jane Irving tries to discover KENYA'S NATIONAL FLOWER

ENGLAND has an undisputed claim to the rose and France has always boasted her fleur-de-lis. Scotland has the thistle and Ireland the shamrock. But what do we look upon as Kenya's national flower?

This week's picture page invites YOU to decide.

I consulted two of our best-known botanical experts on the question and they—Dr. A. J. See-Bohm and Mr. P. W. O. Bully—selected eight from the many exotic and beautiful flowers which grow in Kenya as the most likely candidates for the honour. Six of them are illustrated.

It may be that someone has other ideas but it should be borne in mind that, whatever the choice, the flower should be indigenous to the Colony.

BOTH botanists agreed that the most ornamental and spectacular flower of all is the Clitoria Lily, illustrated bottom right; it grows from 8,000 feet to coast level but it is not confined to East Africa nor even to the African Continent. Common around Nairobi, it varies in colour, the most frequently found being an striking red and yellow.

Readers are invited to send in their choice as 'National Flower' Editorial Department, East African Standard. From replies received a letter will be compiled of flowers in three order of popularity.

It is perhaps significant that this flower was chosen by Dr. See-Bohm for the cover of the book, *Gardening in East Africa*, which he edited. It was chosen, too, by the Kenya Horticultural Society as the emblem for its badge for its members. Her Majesty the Queen owns the flower in jewelled-branch form.

Spatheola (Panicum) is just another way of saying Nairobi. It is a native grass which needs no introduction to Kenya people who witness on masses of red flowers along its dry path daily. They appear at a height of 10 feet or more on the Nairobi Flume Tree and are remarkably long. Their large and narrow leaves are more than for their graceful design or proportion. The tree grows in tropical and sub-tropical Africa as well as in Kenya and can stand up to drought.



Only one of the eight flowers is indigenous solely to Kenya. It is *Barotia Prunella*, top right. Children call it 'Jammy Mouth' because the bright vermilion and yellow-spotted petals have darker markings in the centre which give a 'jammy' effect. A good hedge plant, it grows from 2,000 feet to 8,000 feet and is found everywhere in the Colony and especially in the Kapsabet, Elgeyo and Nandi Districts.

Chamaecrista (Cassia) is a very attractive flower in botanical gardens. It is a very attractive flower and grows with numerous tubular flowers arranged in a large terminal raceme. It is found all over the tropics and has the habit of turning up in remote places where its seed often reaches the countries via the routes of trade.

It is 1500 feet above sea level in the Pyramia Lily or *Crinum* flower. One of our best flowering plants, it has large white and red-striped trumpet flowers and is widely distributed in tropical Africa, from the coast to the highlands. There are many species of the *Crinum* in Kenya, but the *Crinum* is the most graceful.

A flower with small habits is the Humana *Davura* or *Androschima*, middle left. Wherever it rains, the *Davura* comes to life. A delicate pure white and red-veined flower, it is a narrow-leaved plant and is found in grasslands, scrubland and on the steep slopes of the mountains. It is a native of the mountains and is evergreen in Kenya. The flowers are white and they vary in size. The botanical name is *Androschima* because it is a member of the *Androschima* genus and has a bright orange flower rather like a primrose in shape. It is seen bottom right.

STOCK KILLINGS: NEARLY 100 ARRESTS MADE Police pursue suspects far up Mount Kenya

PROMPT and effective police action has done much to suppress the widespread but hitherto unexplained wholesale massacre of stock on European farms in the Tsimba and Nanyuki Districts. It was reported on Sunday, November 22, that Kikuyu have been made by the regular police reinforced by 40 constables from the Northern Frontier District and the Training School at Nanyuki, and members of the Kenya Police Reserve.

Incursions which were in a raiding rather than in a punitive character have been prosecuted with the utmost vigour. In many instances police officers and men have been on duty for up to 30 hours. The trail led to almost the top of the forest line on Mount Kenya.

Supervising the investigation is the Senior Super. H. R. Walker, in charge of the Nyero District, who is assisted by Asst. Super. M. Oswald and Asst. Inspectors Oddie and Davies.

The number of sheep and cattle brutally put to death during the outbreak early on Friday morning is now estimated at 200.

Individual losses are given as—Mr. J. W. A. Harris, 40 steers and heifers; Mr. R. McD. Robertson, 55 steers and cows in-calf and 230 sheep.

It has been reported that the total casualties among the sheep, Mr. Harris, 111; Mr. Robertson, 37; Mr. Tucker, three high-grade Jersey cows; and Mr. Walker, 100.

Death-roll still unknown in triple train crash

HOLIDAY TRAINING IN THE WORLD'S OLDEST SHIP



SIX bells of the morning watch and a stiff, cool breeze blowing in from Spitzbaard. Twelve-year-old Keith Rutherford, of 281 North Lewis Sea Terrace, has stowed his hammock on the dark main deck of the ancient frigate Fouquieroy and, as the boat's pipe shrills, he trots away to fall in with the rest of the "hands" to swab the upper deck.

During the rest of the year he has learned how to pull a boat on a wheeled dolly and draw up a ton of fresh green water. Now for a while he will be in with the maintenance crew, or perhaps work a beer can with the "bosun," but he is a member of a crew, a part of the "crew" of the ship, the oldest British Frigate, built in 1817.


Just after breakfast and still used to a bed. The dunnage and now only her main mast, that being something of a jolly effort. The instructors are qualified professional sea-faring men who were active officers in the Royal or Merchant Navy. The First Lieutenant of the ship himself received his boy's training in Fouquieroy when she was a full-time training ship for prospectors planning to make their careers at sea.

The ship has been described as "a wonder of the world—the last of the frigates left of the Old Navy," and she is a delight to the last of private individuals who consider that her loss, quite apart from depriving South of a national sea-going museum, would be a national disaster. She was built in Bombay in 1817, of oak, for the East India Company. She was first commissioned in the Royal Navy in the Freetown, a 40-gun


