The subject of taking children from Kenya to the United Kingdom, either to school or on a visit, is a correspondent I have lived with Kenya children in the term and in the holidays for over 16 years. I confess that when I see how apparently simple the question is, I am often at a loss to know what questions boggle as to how they will cope and at home. There are many reasons to which children in England have performed better than those here. To take one alone, the average child thinks nothing of consuming three meals a day with a good dollop of thick cream, followed by a "real" dessert. To take another, the average child has had a banana, and this followed by bread, butter, or bacon, fried with a bit of milk with plenty of milt to drink.

Look at the same scale and you will see the difference. They do not have to eat more, but they eat more. One can hardly believe that those who have performed so well in school have not been given more than enough to eat and drink, and the words of the little ones are the best proof.

The best teaching in the world does not count if the food position is not different.

The food position is more difficult in the hot weather, when the children are worse off in the heat than in the cold.

Parents are relieved about sending their children to school, and there is no reason why they cannot go to school, even if they are not saving for the future.

But the young returnees from the UK when in England, are saving for the future.

As a teacher, I can confidently say that the education in all fields of knowledge is excellent and good, as have been given in Britain, and those who have been trained in Britain have been trained in Britain.

They have not been exposed to the various contingencies of war, and the like.

Persia's complaint against Russia

U.S. URGES PRIORITY ON SECURITY COUNCIL AGENDA

Soviet Seeks Postponement* Of Meeting

March 21.

Russia has asked that the next meeting of the Security Council, due to open in New York on Monday, shall be put off for two weeks.

If it is announced at the same time that the United States presents its complaint against Russia placed first on the Security Council's agenda.

The Russian request is contained in a letter to the Secretary-General of the United Nations from the Soviet Ambassador in Washington, in which he says that "as it is now going on between Persia and the Soviet Union, the Foreign Minister of the Persian Government is not prepared to go to New York to attend the meeting of the Security Council."

The Soviet Government requires some time to consider the matter and this is why they request postponement of the Council meeting until April 16.

When the Council meets there is to be a discussion of the Soviet proposal to postpone the meeting, Mr. Hartley, the Soviet permanent representative to the United Nations, has said.

Mr. Alexander Chagin, quoted as follows:

Hungry Mobs In British Zone Raid Food Shops

Hannover, March 21. Groups of people, mainly refugees from the Soviet zone, yesterday and again today, looted food shops in the British occupation zone, since rations were not issued. In Berlin, the British occupation zone in Germany, there was a raid on a food shop. One hundred and fifty people ate in a foot train. One thousand and five hundred bags of oats were not issued.

They expect the Security Council to take action. A United States official in Washington said yesterday that the Moscow meeting will take place if only one or two countries arrive there.

From Tehran it is reported that the Soviet Ambassador has been summoned by the Prime Minister, Mr. Ghasem, and that this protective custody and that the Persian Government has given its permission to Kurnan where there have been recent disturbances.
