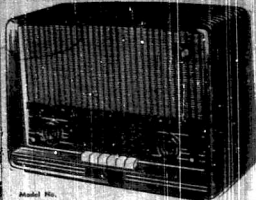

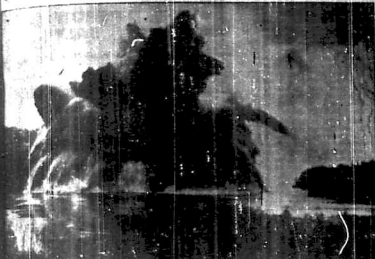

SEVEN EXTRA SEATS

FINAL results in the South African General Election have put the National Party, under the Prime Minister, Mr. Strijdom, back in power for a third successive five-year term, with seven seats more than they had in the old Assembly.

It was the first time in the country's 48-year political history that voters have given a Government the opportunity of serving for an unbroken spell of 15 years.

It was the first time that Parliament will be without representatives of other than the two main parties—the National Party, which has 108 seats, and the United Party, which won 53 seats.

Opposition leader defeated

The United Party gained one seat from the Nationalists. The National Party gains at the expense of the Labour Party and the Independent Members of the House of Assembly.

The United Party leader, Sir de Villiers Graaf, fought and lost a game battle against all-comparable demoralized odds in his constituency of Hofmattiesfontein, in the Cape. But he has now offered "safe" seats by at least five members of his party who have returned to Parliament.
