

EXCHEQUER GRIPS STATELY HOMES OF BRITAIN

EXECUTORS of the largest private estate in the world, the Duke of Westminster, have sold the British Government a substantial interest in the estate, which has been valued at £1,100,000. The sale, which was completed last week, is the largest of its kind since the war. The Duke of Westminster, who is the owner of the estate, has sold the Government a 25 per cent. interest in the estate, which includes the famous Grosvenor Gardens in London. The sale is part of a series of transactions which the Duke has been carrying out in connection with the estate. The Duke is believed to be worth over £10,000,000. The sale of the estate to the Government is a significant event, as it marks the first time that a private estate of this size has been sold to the Government since the war. 



In accordance with their declared intention, the African Elected Members took no part in the proceedings. One Asian Member, Mr. J. M. Nazareth, of the Western Area, was absent. When the Speaker, Sir Ferdinand Cavendish, declared the results, there were 48 Members present.

By-elections to fill the resultant vacancies on the Elected Members will be held before the first week in June. At least three weeks' notice has to be given of nomination day and there must be an interval of at least two weeks between nomination day and polling day.

- 3—Ensuring that individual rights of private property are respected.

On land, the Colonial Secretary speaks of an attitude based on the principles of racial harmony and the most advantageous employment of natural resources, and mentions of good reservations "a co-operative endeavour to use and conserve the fertile soil of Kenya for the lasting prosperity of all its inhabitants present and future."
