Warning on strikes by Ministers

A JOINT statement by the Ministers for Finance, Education and Health in Kampala this week forbade major changes in industrial rates.

The statement came after talks in Kampala by Uganda's Mr. Omania, Kenya's Mr. Mbuja and Tanganyika's Mr. Kamaliza, and resulted in a warning that strikes and lockouts could not be afforded at the present time.

The national interest could be prejudiced by irresponsible actions, whether they were made by employers or by trade unions, the Ministers said, and called on both sides to play their part in nation-building.

Other points made were that East Africa must move to a high wage economy, and that something be done about social security. Unemployment, they agreed, was a serious threat to security, and must be treated as an emergency measure by the Government.
