



## Battle of unions at T.U.C.







# Two African girls show home aids

FOR at least a year Riruta residents will have a special "one stop" service to show them the advantages of electricity and also the latest and most economical way to use it.

One of the houses will contain a demonstration room and kitchen, where two African girls will be available to give advice and help - and also to give a little hand-learned.

**TYPICAL HOUSE**





# Family housing at Mvuruta

## MINISTER OPENS TOWN

MVURUTA, 10 miles from Harare, was opened to private investors (Mr. Amalamba) of Harare, for a family housing in the Mvuruta area, just outside the city boundaries of Harare, was opened officially yesterday by the Minister for Housing, Mr. Amalamba.

Chief of the housing trust residents, Dr. J. C. Kwaan, Minister for Central Province, South, said people living at Mvuruta, most did not realize that money to buy and build the houses had been lent to them and not given.

Mr. Amalamba said the idea of building Mvuruta was approved in 1938. The intention was to provide good housing for the people living in and around the Mvuruta area. The first houses were built in 1942.

He said there were a number of years. Kwaan had bought land in Mvuruta and built 100 houses. They had been sold for about 10 years ago.

A little cooperation between those concerned in the Mvuruta area, the Mvuruta Trust, the City Council and the Government, would produce the results we are now achieving.

At Mvuruta four standard types of houses had been designed. From these a choice could be made. Each design was suitable for construction in one, two or three stages, according to the financial capacity of the owner.

In addition, mortgage facilities of up to 75 per cent of the building cost, repayable over a period of up to 31 years, had been made available to plot holders.

Plot owners were allowed to buy larger plots than the limits of the standard design. Some of these had just been completed for Dr. Kwaan and two others were being built.

Exchange possible. However, as money is limited, an exchange scheme for this scheme must be operated in a way that would be of benefit to all concerned. Mr. Amalamba said.

As the Minister had concluded that Kwaan was willing to exchange his land for plots in the area which were to be bought by the Government. Many people who did this had more than one plot at Mvuruta.

A group of limited means could be made up of a house of two rooms at first, and then add to it as the means improved, or when an additional loan was granted.

Mr. Amalamba said a down payment of £50 and four repayments at the rate of 25/- a month for 12 years would buy a house with two rooms, a kitchen and a small bathroom, costing £275.

The scheme was started nine months ago. Thirty houses were built and 21 more were being built.


