The February meeting of Nairobi Municipal Council, held on Tuesday afternoon, lasted for about two and a half hours. At the conclusion of that time, the Council went into committee for a purpose not stated, but there was one report of the major business transacted: labor case details of other matters which came before the Council.

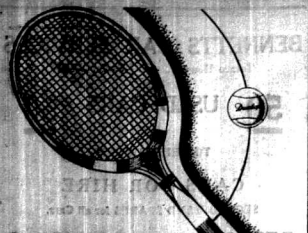

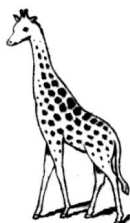



COINAGE TRIAL IN NAIROBI.

Allegations Against Three Indians.

Army of Evidence in Court.

EVIDENCE OF GOVERNMENT ANALYST.

Four counts of coinage were preferred against three Sikhs at the Criminal Sessions which commenced at the Supreme Court, Nairobi, yesterday, before Mr. Justice Home. Ram Singh, Shankar Singh—two elderly bearded men, and a younger man, were the accused.

The first count charged them with counterfeiting, i.e. by making counterfeit coins resembling or so nearly imitating the genuine, or pass for genuine and current coins. The remaining three counts alleged preparation for making coins of various denominations, the possession of certain tools, instruments or machines for making coins, and the possession of tools for cutting round blanks out of gold, silver or other metal, knowing those tools were intended to be used for making any counterfeit coin.

To these counts they were represented by four counsel, pleaded "not guilty."

At Nairobi, Kenya.

On November 16 last, stated the Solicitor General, Mr. T. D. Bruce, appearing for the Crown, a number at Nairobi's bank received from an Indian a deposit of Rs. 100/- in two paper bank notes. Each was weighed, and one was heavier than the other; on counting the coins, certain were considered spurious, and were subsequently sent to the Currency Office.

The following day Ram Singh took the 40/- note to the National Bank of India and asked that they be changed for cash. The shillings were returned as not being genuine, and an examination was made of the other notes. Ram Singh was asked to wait, and the police were called.

The use of a search warrant did not reveal anything in Ram Singh's room, but on his person were found receipts for 115 lbs. of rolling machines and for 115 lbs. of German silver. "They might represent part of the equipment for making counterfeit coins," commented the Solicitor General, who then turned to the premises, behind the National Bank of India, of Babbar Singh, a goldsmith and carpenter's shop. Here were die-stamps, prepared by the Government Analyst, Mr. M. H. Fox, to test the stamp, and a quantity of counterfeit coinage was being carried on Babbar's anwers counter. Five apparatus were also highly unsatisfactory, added the Crown. Mr. Bell, a director of Messrs. Hart and Bell, would be called to give evidence regarding the die-stamps which Mr. Fox would say could be used as part of a counterfeiting outfit.

went to the house of Martha Singh at Molo and searched it. Here he found eight spurious coins. Witness's companions, as stated by Superintendent Stewart, was the marking of bottom of being into the die, but he could not produce one of these imitations.

Over a month later, in December 1933, Superintendent Stewart received three more spurious coins from one Sir Singh at Nairobi. Police Station at the same time Inspector Clifton gave him another coin and various imitations. Sir Singh's presence at Molo was announced on the following day, and 120 blank with milled edges and serrations of the reverse and obverse sides of the striking. One mould had a re-entrant rolling ring. Following traces of the piece, several failed to hold a coin while it was polished, were among other exhibits taken from Sir Singh's house. A cruet which had been used to make a drink, and tongs for lifting the metal.

Over 40 Exhibits

In all, there were over 40 exhibits which Superintendent Stewart put in.

had got him inside for a long period. The strips of metal produced, but he had in them where discovered. The metal was made up by the Police. Other articles were also sent by witness to the laboratory at Molo, including four small finger rings of a brass colour, some aluminium screws, bolts and a washing tin.

Government Analyst

Morris Henry Fox, Government Analyst, was the next witness. He declared that he had examined the various articles and had received certain information from Superintendent Stewart and was provided in a notebook label of the National Bank of India. He saw Bladen Singh and Superintendent Stewart.

The specimens were used for the making of metals and moulding. There were two lamps, one with a blast, a quantity of moulding sand, a considerable amount of waste copper and some aluminium scrap.

Witness asked by Bladen Singh regarding the value of the articles, he was used for, and Bladen Singh replied that he was a metal worker. Witness requested that a demonstration of barium-making be given, but no witness was prepared. Witness pointed up some strips of metal and asked Bladen Singh what they were for, and he pointed to some aluminium scrap. Strip of Metal

On November 21 witness received from Inspector Percival, three large strips of metal, two small strips of metal, seven pieces of brass metal, and two screws each containing five shillings. On the same day witness received a broken strip of metal from Superintendent Stewart.

There were four aluminium strips and one of steel, all with bevelled edges. On two of the strips had been used for making an impression of a mould in sand. The bevelled edges enabling the strips to be removed cleanly from the mould. One piece was copper, one was white metal, and a casting, fastened by rolling. A further two strips were made from sand casting, and were alloys of copper, steel and iron.

Coin Shown

Witness later mentioned the 10 coins and found that they were counterfeit. He examined them superficially and then microscopically, and discovered flaws. He also explained the process of examination. On several other further steps number of some were handed to witness by Superintendent Stewart. He examined them and found them all to be spurious. The spurious coins were made of a similar alloy as the coin strip previously mentioned.

Contents of Bottle

Witness examined the contents of the bottles found in Bladen Singh's premises. In a small glass bottle were aluminium crystals, and in a bottle was a strongly alkaline liquid containing silver crystals, suitable for the silver plating of brass metal. Other bottles contained nitric acid, an alkaline solution of cyanide, a dark coloured metal, copper nitrate and nickel being present; and a liquid containing copper sulphate. All these articles were useful for the purposes of counterfeiting.

On February 12 witness received five discs from Superintendent Stewart which discs he examined and found them to be alloys of copper, nickel and zinc in varying quantities. The discs probably came from different castings, the quantities varied on the different strips produced. Witness could not say whether the metal produced were more profitable for the coins previously produced. The wire of adapted for the use of making coins. Of the spurious coins examined by witness the majority came from the same series of stamps according to the date year.

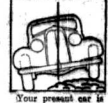

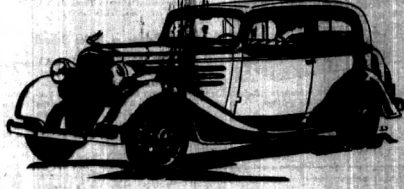

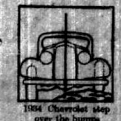

of this Colony depends almost solely on increased European settlement. I agree that it would be disastrous to the Colony, and grossly unfair to the individual, to encourage settlement by persons who have not sufficient capital to enable them a reasonable chance of making good in this Colony, but I am none the less certain that this Colony affords an almost unique home for those who have sufficient capital to afford on farming ventures, or for those who wish merely to reside here and who have been even remotely connected with any steady or reasonable income. The cost of living in this Colony at present, at any rate outside the metropolitan area, is extraordinarily low, the climate is magnificent, and the attractions generally unsurpassed.

The Kenya Association (K.A.) has already done a great deal to further white settlement in Kenya, and I can undertake, as far as lies in my power, to give it every possible support.

Taxation. Although the Income Tax question is now a dead letter, I think it only right that I should say that my views as to the undesirability of such a tax in a young and developing Colony, as so often expressed in the past, have not altered.

I have that our present system of taxation, based on the Poll Tax, is opposed to the direct method of taxation as far as money is concerned, and I do not believe in the present economic conditions it would be anything but a step towards a revival of the methods of taxation which I have already pledged to support on the repeal of the present Poll Tax and Purveyance Tax Ordinance at the end of the present year, as these taxes were put on as purely temporary measures to bridge a temporary deficit, and I am also pledged to see that the present Licensing Ordinance is completely revised by a competent Committee, in what is recognized as an inevitable Ordinance which will be amended, and a fair and proper measure substituted therefor. I also think that consideration should be given to the present position of individuals

under the age of 21 years, especially apprentices, who, while not having the right to exercise the franchise, are still liable to pay Poll and Education taxes.

Finally, on taxation, I would suggest that the time has come when consideration should be given as to whether the present system of each community being taxed for the education of its own people should, or should not, be continued.

Civil Service. The opinion has been expressed that for some reason or other my views towards the Civil Service have changed during the last two years, and I can give a complete assurance that such is not the case.

I have never been even remotely connected with any attacks on the Service and I have on many occasions in Legislative Council expressed the view that the Service has every reason to be proud of its work on behalf of the Colony.

I have for many years done my best to safeguard the interest of the Service, and my task has not always been an easy one, and I think I am entitled to ask that I should be judged by nearly twelve years' record, and not merely by odd incidents in which the Service and I may not have seen eye to eye.

With regard to the levy on official salaries, I would like to make it clear that I look upon this as a purely temporary contribution to enable the Budget of the Colony to be balanced, and that I would oppose to the utmost any attempt to retain the levy in order to build up surplus balances.

I have been asked whether I would pledge myself to support the abolition of the levy at the end of the present year, irrespective of the financial position of the Colony, and my answer is that I can give no such undertaking. I hope, and believe, that it will be possible to balance the Budget without, or with a very small reduction, levy, but I cannot pledge myself to press for its abolition if such abolition would result in an unbalanced Budget.

For the rest, I have always tried in the past to take up and press any points that have been brought to my notice by the Civil Service either individually or collectively—and I can undertake that if I am returned I shall

do just as ready to do as much in the future.

Education. It is obvious that if Kenya is to progress as we all hope, that it is of the greatest importance that the education which is afforded should be of the best, and I am therefore prepared to support a system of compulsory primary education, such education being free in all necessary cases.

I also welcome the recent introduction of the principle of overseas scholarships for Kenya children, and I believe that every opportunity must be afforded to those educated in this Colony to enter the Civil Service, whether in Kenya or overseas, and to have a right of priority thereto, provided that the standard of efficiency is maintained—there is no reason that it should not be.

I also consider that immediate provision should be made for the erection of an adequate High Secondary School, and in this respect consideration might be given as to whether it would not be possible, in view of the present low cost of building, to allocate the necessary money out of Loan Funds available, but at present committed for other building activities.

The need for a proper European Hospital requires no demonstration, and if Government funds are not at present available I would suggest that enquiries be made as to whether it would not be possible for private enterprise to erect the necessary hospital on Government land, making in lease it for a period of years and thereafter purchase it at valuation.

Crime and Police.

In view of the reportable increase in crime in certain districts, I consider that enquiries should be instituted as to whether, in spite of the monthly of enquiries, conditions must carefully, a further increase in the police rate is not justified. I also consider that the present law with regard to native searching lamps after sunset in Townships should be most rigidly enforced.

Mining.

I am prepared to support to the utmost any Legislation beneficial to the Mining Industry, and I am not at all certain that a wise Government looking ahead—instead of to the immediate present—would not materially reduce, or abolish at least temporarily, the payment of royalties.

I consider that elected members of this Colony must not be con-

sidered as being in the same position as an official opposition in England, and that they are not intended to oppose to the bill any measure introduced by Government, or introduced by any other member of their view, so detrimental to the best interests of the Colony, but they are equally under a duty to suggest to Government steps to be taken, whether by legislation or otherwise, which will benefit the Colony, and as far as possible to co-operate with Government in its work for the general good of the Colony as a whole, and I therefore think that to talk about an "opposition," or to centre-delineate Government by Agreement, is a wholly misleading.

If the elected representatives of the people will work as a team, and give the benefit of their knowledge and experience to Government, and will insist on what they believe to be in the best interests of the Colony, I am certain that we and our children can not assured that by arbitrary action by any Government at home can possibly succeed.

Finally, may I remind you that during the past twelve years I have of necessity gained a great deal of experience and that as an active member during that period I have acquired a very intimate knowledge of the history of the Colony and the machinery of Government, and I would suggest, for your consideration, that this experience may be of a returned, of considerable benefit to those whom I shall represent.

I am quite ready to admit that I have made mistakes in the past—no politician does not—and I think I can say that I have not spent myself, and that I have done my utmost to further the interests of those who returned me to Council, and I can guarantee that so long as I remain a Member I shall continue to give of my best to the Colony which I have made my home.

Meeting Notes.

While it is impossible for me to interview each voter individually, I am, as you are aware, holding weekly meetings in different parts of the Constituency, and also propose to hold one or more public meetings. In addition to this, I am only too ready to attend any meetings which may be arranged, and I would welcome the opportunity of meeting voters and answering any questions that they may raise.
