HUMAN BLOOD BANK MAY HAVE TO CLOSE

'Struggle' to obtain donors

BECAUSE of a lack of co-operation by some sections of the Asian community, the Asian blood transfusion service operated in Kenya by the British Red Cross Society is becoming increasingly difficult to run and unless more donors are found, the service may have to close down. This is stated in the 1958 annual report of the Kenya branch of the Society which has just been published.

The report states that although calls have been sent out at different times to the public to donate blood, the service has not been able to keep the bank open each month, and it is doubtful whether even this method will be sufficient for the Asian community.

This would be a great pity for the Asian community, the report adds. The only way to solve the problem is to get more donors, who have formed the greatest barrier in keeping the bank open.

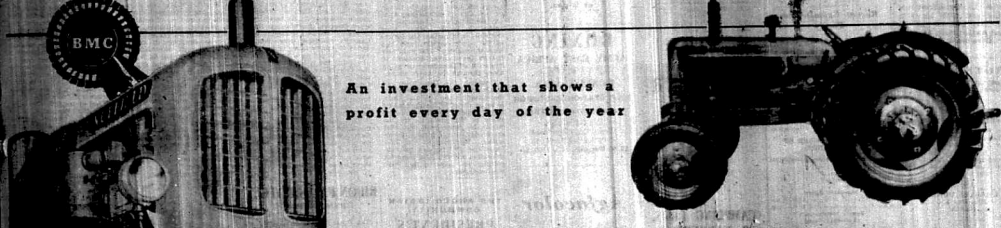

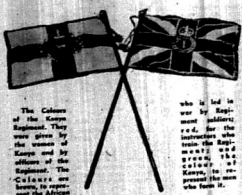

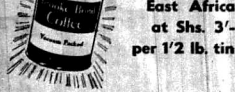

RESTORERS OF THE TAJ MAHAL RACE AGAINST TIME

FEARS for the safety of the Taj Mahal, the famous white marble mausoleum of a Moghul emperor, are being widely expressed in Agra, India. When cracks were reported recently in the main building, the Superintendent of Agra Fort, Mr. B. Lal, said: "There is no cause for alarm. But Indian press correspondents have taken up the statement immediately after its publication. They are distinct signs of deterioration in the main mausoleum. They are saying its job hands on this emergency of international concern as a rule it will continue to attract people and the condition is comparatively good even after these cracks. It would be a pity to allow it to decay."

The cost ABOUT 100,000 rupees will be spent this year on repairs to the Taj Mahal, keeping up the constant battle to preserve its pristine glory, which has gone on ever since it was completed in 1653. It is a memorial to Mumtaz Mahal, wife of Emperor Shah Jahan. She had died in 1657 in giving birth to her fourteenth child. According to many reports, Prince Aurangzeb, who finally became one of the great Moghul Emperors of India, had added to the structure by the addition of a new entrance to the building.
