





unbalanced policy, which pegs Officers, more Police, is not the solution. The foundations of the creation of a strong and willing life and atmosphere in Africa must be built up from within. Africa must be separated from their direction, of what the real problems of Native Policy are, how they are being created, and how we can best meet them. People, official and unofficial, should be more patiently trying to do in these countries.

The setback to the Kenya Government's attempts to find a solution to the agricultural and social problem presented by the regeneration of the Native Reserves, is another disquieting aspect of Native Policy and of the difficulties involved in it. Judged from the standpoint of sound agricultural theory and practice, the present endeavour to regenerate the Kamba country is a balanced approach of developing agriculture, complementary and dovetailed, is coming to be appreciated as a hopeful advance along a long and weary road.
