INVESTING BRITISH MONEY Claims of The Colonial Empire

BUT NEW SYSTEM NEEDED

A few weeks ago the House of Commons was impressed by a suggestion that there should be set up a Colonial Committee which would assist the Secretary of State with the application of British Policy in the Colonial Empire and keep the House in close touch with affairs in the Dependencies.

This has been followed by a discussion which began in the correspondence columns of "The Times" on the important question of the British Government's financial policy in the Colonies. That is the subject which Mr. H. V. Hodson, the well-known writer and broadcaster on imperial matters, discusses in the special article below.

There has been a great deal of talk in the past few years about the need for a new system of investing British money in the Colonies. It is not surprising that this should be so, for the fact is that the present system is not only inefficient but also wasteful.

The present system is based on the principle that the Government should invest in the Colonies as much as it can afford to do. This is a very simple and direct method, but it has many drawbacks.

One of the main objections to the present system is that it does not take account of the needs of the Colonies. The Government invests in the Colonies as if they were a single block, without regard to the different requirements of the various territories.

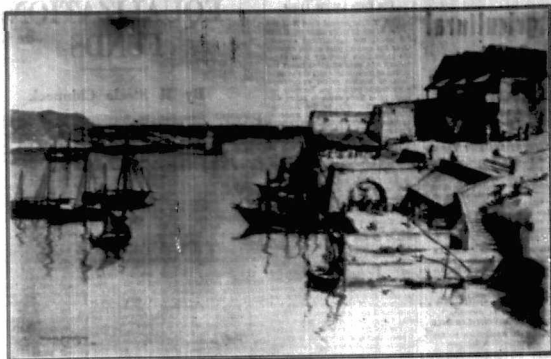

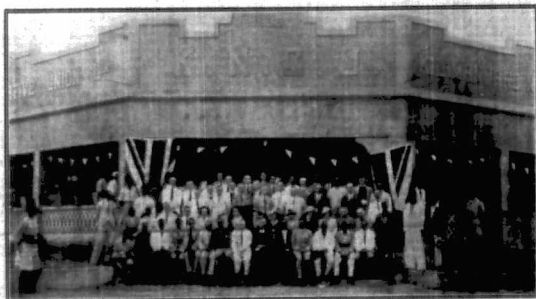

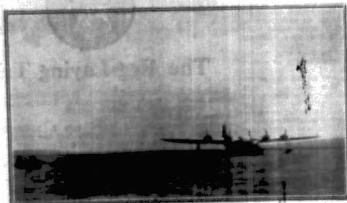
