British Board of Trade took a rigid and discouraging view of colonial industrial development on the grounds that it might prove costly to bring about an alteration in outlook and the attention which is now being given to the needs of the colonial Empire in Parliamentary and other interested circles in Britain are together having a profound effect on the official mind. It is a quiet but not a negligible fact that the experience of the last decade that young Colonies can no longer be regarded as a mere appendage to the mother country. The economic structure based on a purely agricultural foundation is insufficiently sound to enable the colonies to provide adequate encouragement for the start to develop. Nor is it possible for the Territories, which East Africa provides a good example of, to carry the load of local development of social, scientific and other essential co-operative requirements of countries in the making if their financial resources have to be restricted by the national and represented only by agricultural production which is subject to price factors and international trade policies beyond local control. 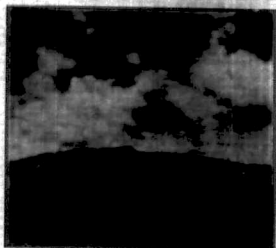
