The Nairobi University Press has received K.Shs. 100,000/- from the Kenya Reinsurance Corporation to enable it expand its publishing undertaking.

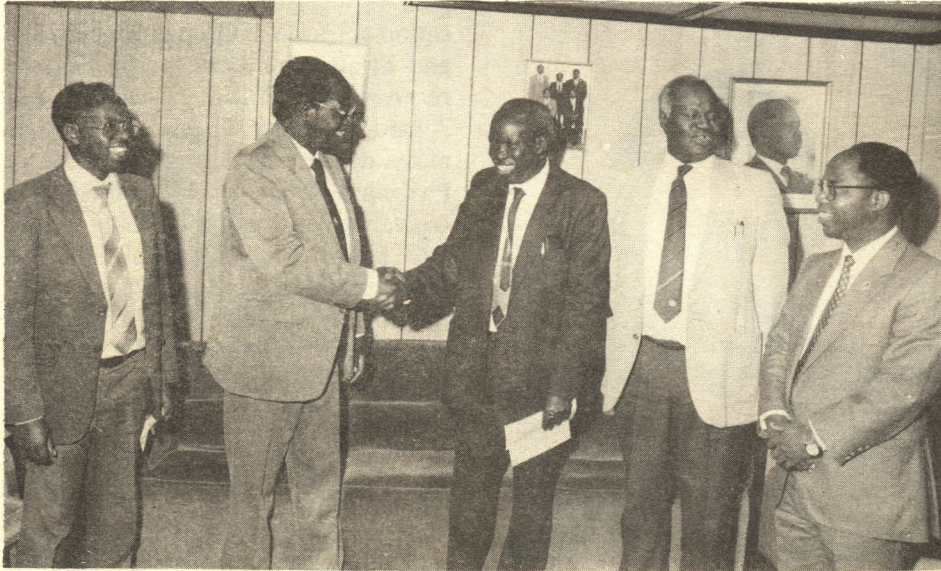
During the short presentation ceremony, the Corporation's Chairman, Prof. S.H. Ominde, said that the University of Nairobi plays a vital role in manpower development for national
