

**SUMMARY FOR THE WEBSITE ON THE 2014 M&E TRAINING
OPENING SPEECH BY PROFESSOR MURUNGARU KIMANI,
DIRECTOR, PSRI**

The tenth edition of the annual PSRI two-week M&E training workshop for population and health programmes for 2014, was officially opened on Monday August 18th 2014, in the Confucius Conference Center in the Education Building.

During the opening ceremony, the Director, PSRI Prof Murungaru Kimani, noted that M&E has now been recognized as a standard management tool for enhancing the effectiveness and impact of programmes through increased evidence based decision making. He observed that the training will be handled in fourteen sessions which are all linked and covers various components of the M&E Plan, which is the key expected output at the end of the workshop.

The thirteen participants at the workshop who are drawn from GOK and NGOs were challenged to ensure that they achieved similar results on completion of
