- Tolerate

- Treat

- Transfer

- Terminate

- Resourcing controls
- Reaction Planning
- Reporting & monitoring risk performance
- Reviewing the Risk Management framework

Disaster management will involve training on plans through which Kenya Science Community should reduce vulnerability to hazards and cope with disasters.
