

SKILLS LAB ACCREDITATION



The College of Health Sciences skills lab is seeking accreditation with the Society for Simulation in Health Care (SSiH), an international council for accreditation of healthcare simulation programs. The council requires programs applying for accreditation to demonstrate compliance with the society's established standards and criteria.

The College of Health Sciences Multi-Disciplinary Skills Lab(MDSL) coordinating committee and members of faculty held a two day workshop to prepare a self- study report that describes how the Skills lab complies with the standards of SSiH accreditation.

Participants were faculty from the four schools that utilize the skills lab for clinical instruction (Nursing, Medicine, Dental Sciences and Pharmacy) and University of Maryland Baltimore, a collaborating institution.

The two-day workshop was facilitated by Professor Jeremy Penner, senior technical advisor, University of Maryland Baltimore assisted by the skills laboratory manager.
