

CASELAP PARTICIPATES AT AFRICAN CLIMATE CHANGE WORKSHOP AT UNIVERSITY OF GHANA, LEGON



CASELAP Faculty Dr. Robert Kibugi travelled to Accra, Ghana at the end of September to attend an African Climate Change Workshop to discuss the concept of Earth Systems Governance, and possible collaborative research areas. The workshop brought together scholars from Kenya, Uganda, South Africa, Nigeria, Ghana, Netherlands and Sweden. Supported by START (www.start.org), the Workshop was hosted by the Institute for Environmental Studies and Sanitation at the University of Ghana. Habtezion, while Prof Chris Gordon from the University of Ghana chaired the proceedings.

The two day workshop, held between 23-24 September 2013, resulted in several outcomes that are important to the research agenda of CASELAP, and the University of Nairobi. The participants will develop a Discussion paper to be published in a peer reviewed journal. Also, an African Chapter to undertake Earth Systems Governance research was formed. In order to advance sharing knowledge and research, participants resolved to develop an interactive web portal to serve as a repository, sharing and dissemination too.
