

PRESENTATION OF SUMMARY REPORT ON FOOD SECURITY IN NAIROBI COUNTY



The African Women's Study Centre (AWSC) of the University of Nairobi under its Food Security Project *Zero Tolerance to Hunger* conducted a National baseline survey from 25th June to 2nd July 2013 in 20 counties spread among the different agro-ecological zones. The objective of the survey was to gather information on food security and nutritional status as well as collecting innovative proposals and recommendations that can be incorporated in food security policy programmes for a better outcome towards the achievement of Article 43 (1) (c) of the Kenya Constitution.

Following the successful field work, Prof. Gakuru of the Department of Sociology and Social Work, Penina Oganda from the Department of Political Science and Dr. Mbithi from the School of Economics on Tuesday 26th November 2013 presented the summary of findings and recommendations for food security in Nairobi County to the female MPs from the county for their input.
