

## **Call for applications: Civilian Training Programme Indian Technical & Economic Cooperation (ITEC) 2015 - 2016**

The Indian Technical and Economic Cooperation (ITEC) Programme is a bilateral programme of assistance of the Government of India. The programme is fully funded by the Government of India.

There are 47 empanelled institutions conducting 280 short-term, medium-term and long-term courses.

The training programme is demand driven and subjects selected are of interest to developing countries for working professional in a wide and diverse range of skills and disciplines.

Courses are divided into seven broad categories

- Accounts, audit, banking and finance
- IT, Telecommunications, and English
- Management
- SME/Rural Development
- Specialized courses
- Technical courses
- Environmental and Renewable Energy

### **Eligibility**

- Adequate work experience
- Be between 25 to 45 years

Applications should reach the High Commission three (3) months prior to commencement of the course or as per application requirements stated by individual collaborating India-based institutions.
