

Afrobarometer Study Results Out

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The Afrobarometer Round 5 findings on the constitution of Kenya, economic performance, freedom of expression and democratisation were released recently.

The Afrobarometer is a comparative series of national public opinion surveys that measure public attitudes towards democracy, governance, the economy, leadership and related issues. The results are produced collaboratively by social scientists from more than 30 African countries. The study is coordinated at the Institute for Development Studies.

The findings were released by Prof Winnie Mitullah, Dr Paul Kamau, Dr Adams Oloo and Dr Joshua Kivuva.
