COMESA WORKSHOP PRESENTATION BY DR. J.K. GATHUMBI HELD IN UGANDA ON 24TH AND 27TH AUGUST 2015.

Dr. J.K. Gathumbi, Senior Lecturer in the Dept of Vet, Pathology, Microbiology and Parasitology did a presentation in a Comesa workshop held in Uganda on 24th and 27th August 2015.

The aim of the workshop was, to offer training and build capacity on aflatoxin sampling, (ISO 17025 laboratory requirements) and COMESA aflatoxin proficiency testing scheme and coregulation of aflatoxin-safe labelling.

This activity is part of a larger goal of developing a mutual recognition framework for aflatoxin control that is being introduced within COMESA countries to promote trade.
